☞ **Scripture Reading: Daniel 9:2**

2 in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood from the Scriptures, according to the word of the LORD given to Jeremiah the prophet, that the desolation of Jerusalem would last seventy years.

☞ **Sermon:**

Prayers That Shake Heaven and Earth (2) ~ Pastor Dong

Daniel's most amazing prayer is the prayer in Daniel chapter 9!
Let's continue to look at the heart of this prayer and the amazing blessings it brought.

III. Give the highest honor to the LORD God **(Daniel 9:4)**

Daniel 9:4 I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed: "Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and keep his commandments."

When Judah was destroyed and the foreign empires seemed unbeatable, Daniel still believed firmly in the "great and awesome God."

He boldly declared that the LORD alone is the highest ruler of history and of the whole earth.

Who is the LORD God in our hearts?

This determines our attitude, our faith, our urgency, and the results when we pray!

What do we need to confess? That we have disobeyed God's commands. What do we need to believe?

That God is a great and awesome God, and that He keeps His covenant and shows His love.

When we pray, who is the God we are crying out to and asking for help?

IV. Hold tightly to God's character **(Daniel 9:9-10, 18-19)**

Daniel 9:9-10, 18-19, 24 The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against him;

10 we have not obeyed the Lord our God or kept the laws he gave us through his servants the prophets.

18-19 Give ear, our God, and hear; open your eyes and see the desolation of the city that bears your Name.

We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy.

19 Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! For your sake, my God, do not delay, because your city and your people bear your Name."

24 "Seventy 'sevens' are decreed for your people and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the Most Holy Place."

On one hand, Daniel declared that the people deserved what they received and that God's judgment was righteous.

On the other hand, he declared God's mercy!

He asked God simply because of His great mercy. His prayer held tightly to God's mercy, and he cried out to God to fulfill His promise.

What did this kind of prayer bring?

V. See eternity — our vision and spiritual level are lifted higher

When Daniel cried out to God like this, God's answer was shocking and far beyond what he could imagine!

Daniel prayed for Jerusalem, the holy mountain, God's people, and the sanctuary to be restored, and for them to be free from God's anger and the shame around them. (**Daniel 9:16-18**)

Daniel 9:16-18 The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against him;

16 Lord, in keeping with all your righteous acts, turn away your anger and your wrath from Jerusalem, your city, your holy hill. Our sins and the iniquities of our ancestors have made Jerusalem and your people an object of scorn to all those around us.

17 "Now, our God, hear the prayers and petitions of your servant. For your sake, Lord, look with favor on your desolate sanctuary.

18 Give ear, our God, and hear; open your eyes and see the desolation of the city that bears your Name. We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy.

But what God gave was far beyond what he could imagine: eternal reconciliation, perfect holiness and glory, peace and joy. Even a brief glimpse of these things is enough to make us rejoice and be filled!

Daniel's prayer helped him see greater, higher, and deeper revelation. This revelation made his faith stronger, his hope more certain, his spiritual level higher, and his heart more glorious and joyful.

The book of Revelation clearly tells us that this is the gospel of the kingdom that God has already given us today—the gospel that God will bring the new heaven and the new earth and give them completely to us. (**Revelation 21:1-11**)

Revelation 21:1-11 Then I saw “a new heaven and a new earth,”[a] for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. _

2 I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Look! God’s dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.

4 ‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’[b] or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”

5 He who was seated on the throne said, “I am making everything new!” Then he said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.”

6 He said to me: “It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life.

7 Those who are victorious will inherit all this, and I will be their God and they will be my children.

8 But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.”

9 One of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and said to me, “Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.”

10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God.

11 It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

If we cry out for God's people like Daniel did, it is like asking God for a cup of water, but God gives us Niagara Falls!

And even this picture is far too small to describe what God gives us!

This kind of prayer opens our eyes, expands our vision, and lifts us to a much higher level!

“Daniel opened his windows three times a day, faced Jerusalem, and gave thanks and prayed to God.”

He was holding on to the grace Solomon asked God for in his prayer. (**2 Chronicles 6:36-39; 7:12**) God is faithful. He answered Solomon, and He will surely fulfill His promises.

2 Chronicles 6:36-39; 7:12 “When they sin against you—for there is no one who does not sin—and you become angry with them and give them over to the enemy, who takes them captive to a land far away or near;

37 and if they have a change of heart in the land where they are held captive, and repent and plead with you in the land of their captivity and say, ‘We have sinned, we have done wrong and acted wickedly’;

38 and if they turn back to you with all their heart and soul in the land of their captivity where they were taken, and pray toward the land you gave their ancestors, toward the city you have chosen and toward the temple I have built for your Name;

39 then from heaven, your dwelling place, hear their prayer and their pleas, and uphold their cause. And forgive your people, who have sinned against you.

7:12 the Lord appeared to him at night and said: “I have heard your prayer and have chosen this place for myself as a temple for sacrifices.

Galatians 3:7 So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.”

You and I who believe in Jesus are truly God's chosen people of the kingdom of heaven!

Therefore, if you and I pray like Daniel, God will also answer us in ways far beyond what we can imagine!

He will help us live our whole lives with the same faithfulness to God that we had when we were young. He will help us continue to stay close to Him and remain faithful to the end. We will not fall away. Instead, we will live more and more in a way that pleases God, continuing to live with a “beautiful spirit.”

And the most beautiful and amazing thing is this: We can know God's greatest salvation and the peace and joy of His eternal salvation. Even a brief glimpse of it is enough to make us rejoice and be filled!
