🔗**Sermon: Spiritual Epidemic Prevention (I)** ---Pastor Tung

We are alarmingly alerted to current battling against
the COVID-19 pandemic, we need to pay even
more attention to our spiritual confrontation against
never-ending spiritual plagues! We must focus
seriously on this unremitting spiritual battle! We
need to save all plagued spirits!

Inoculate with the most impotent vaccine

【**1John 5:4** for everyone born of God overcomes
the world. This is the victory that has overcome the
world, even our faith.】

**As such, our unyielding faith is the vaccine that
overcomes all spiritual plagues.**

**How can we acquire this faith that is omnipotent
against all spiritual plagues?**

1 Request of the Lord. 【Mak 9:14-29

¹⁴When they came to the other disciples,
they saw a large crowd around them and
the teachers of the law arguing with them.
¹⁵As soon as all the people saw Jesus, they
were overwhelmed with wonder and ran to
greet him. ¹⁶"What are you arguing with
them about?" he asked. ¹⁷A man in the
crowd answered, "Teacher, I brought you
my son, who is possessed by a spirit that
has robbed him of speech. ¹⁸Whenever it
seizes him, it throws him to the ground.
He foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth
and becomes rigid. I asked your disciples
to drive out the spirit, but they could not."
¹⁹"O unbelieving generation," Jesus replied,
"how long shall I stay with you? How
long shall I put up with you? Bring the
boy to me." ²⁰So they brought him.
When the spirit saw Jesus, it immediately
threw the boy into a convulsion. He fell
to the ground and rolled around, foaming at
the mouth. ²¹Jesus asked the boy's father,
"How long has he been like this?" "From
childhood," he answered. ²²"It has often
thrown him into fire or water to kill him.
But if you can do anything, take pity on us
and help us." ²³"If you can?" said Jesus.
"Everything is possible for him who
believes." ²⁴Immediately the boy's father
exclaimed, "I do believe; help me
overcome my unbelief!" ²⁵When Jesus
saw that a crowd was running to the scene,
he rebuked the evil spirit. "You deaf and
mute spirit," he said, "I command you,

come out of him and never enter him again." ²⁶The spirit shrieked, convulsed him violently and came out. The boy looked so much like a corpse that many said, "He's dead." ²⁷But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him to his feet, and he stood up. ²⁸After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" ²⁹He replied, "This kind can come out only by prayer."; **Eph 3:14-21** ¹⁴For this reason I kneel before the Father, ¹⁵from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name. ¹⁶I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹and to know this love that surpasses knowledge--that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. ²⁰Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.】

The first knack to acquire this faith is to request for this unyielding faith from Jesus with earnestness, eagerness, and even with fervid tears! But what if we don't even have enough faith to request from Jesus for this unyielding faith? 【Mak 9:24**】 Then, through fasting and prayers repeatedly request of Jesus for this faith! 【**Mat 17:14-21** ¹⁴When they came to the crowd, a man approached Jesus and knelt before him. ¹⁵ "Lord, have mercy on my son," he said. "He has seizures and is suffering greatly. He often falls into the fire or into**

the water. ¹⁶I brought him to your disciples, but they could not heal him.";

¹⁷"O unbelieving and perverse generation," Jesus replied, "how long shall I stay with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring the boy here to me." ¹⁸Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of the boy, and he was healed from that moment. ¹⁹Then the disciples came to Jesus in private and asked, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" ²⁰He replied, "Because you have so little faith. I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." ²¹【; **Mak 11:24** Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.; **Luk 8:50** Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed."; **Jas 1:6** But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.; **Ezr 8:23** So we fasted and petitioned our God about this, and he answered our prayer.; **Est 4:16** "Go, gather together all the Jews who are in Susa, and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day. I and my maids will fast as you do. When this is done, I will go to the king, even though it is against the law. And if I perish, I perish."】

2 Have knowledge of God 【**Mak 4:36-41**】

³⁶Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. ³⁷A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. ³⁸Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't

you care if we drown?" ³⁹He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. ⁴⁰He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" ⁴¹They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"]

Incessantly strive for knowledge of God, the more abundantly you know God the stronger your faith!

The approaches to know God:

- i. Through listening, bible study, and experience exchange of truth.
- ii. Through learning other's witness and spiritual experience.
- iii. Through submission to and serving the Lord.

3 Pursue the Word was in relation with God and was God.

i. Spread the gospel. [Mat 28:16-20

¹⁶Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. ¹⁷When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. ¹⁸Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."]

- #### **ii. Have love for your neighbors as for yourself. [Jhn 15:10-12**
- ¹⁰If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his

love. ¹¹I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. ¹²My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. **Jhn 3:16** "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **1Jn 3:16** This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers. **1Co 13:7** It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.]

Through our adherence to God's commandments and the grand mission He bestowed on us, the Lord will make his presence with us at all times!

4 Grasp opportunities for mutual encouragement.

[Heb 3:13-14 ¹³But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. ¹⁴We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly till the end the confidence we had at first.] Make hold of all daily opportunities to encourage one another toward holding firmly the confidence we had at first.

5 Be a royal servant of the Lord. [Luk

17:1-10 ¹Jesus said to his disciples: "Things that cause people to sin are bound to come, but woe to that person through whom they come. ²It would be better for him to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around his neck than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin. ³So watch yourselves. "If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him. ⁴If he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times comes back to you and says, 'I repent,' forgive him."

⁵The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" ⁶He replied, "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you. ⁷

"Suppose one of you had a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. Would he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, 'Come along now and sit down to eat'? ⁸Would he not rather say, 'Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink'? ⁹Would he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? ¹⁰ So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.'"

Rom 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. **1Co 15:58** Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. **】**

Take serving the Lord as a royal servant as granted, take serving the Lord as our obligation; whoever serves the Lord, the Lord will bestow on him increased faith.

【 Mat 16:26 What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? **】**

We should first strive for establishing our sound spirit on a firm basis that will not collapse, which is a ground of blessing! Let's first strive for owning eternal life, unfailing home, and everlasting kingdom!

Concluding prayers for our unyielding faith.

- 5 Plea to the Lord that each of us will make the best use of the fellowship; enhance and multiply our faith through our interaction with our Mentor and members!
- 6 Plea to the Lord that each of us will choose to be a lifetime servant of the Lord: taking life-long service of the Lord as our obligation so that we may receive increased faith as the Lord so promised us!
- 7 Plea to the Lord that each of us will be extremely cautious in our fighting against the COVID-19 virus, and that we will put even more weight on our spiritual inoculation so that we may all enjoy everlasting vital peace and salvation!
