## Sermon: Our Life Can Be So Wonderful (I)

---Pastor Tung

At this moment nearing the last days, we Christians must know that: being saints through our belief in Christ Jesus how glorious, honorable, and rich is the life we live! Our latent capability, inner power, good spiritual establishments, and wisdom are all beyond our imagination. 2Co 4:16 instructs us the three connotations of our spiritual life: 1) there is no fear in us; 2) we are inwardly renewed day by day; 3) our sight is focused on the heavenly realm.

### I. Feeble hearts living in fear with no hope of seeing the blessing of the Lord lead us to failure. [2Co 11: 23

Are they servants of Christ? (I am out of my mind to talk like this.) I am more. I have worked much harder, been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and been exposed to death again and again. <sup>24</sup>Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. <sup>25</sup>Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, <sup>26</sup>I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my own countrymen, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false brothers. <sup>27</sup>I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked. <sup>28</sup>Besides everything else, I face daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches. <sup>29</sup>Who is weak, and I do not feel weak? Who is led into sin, and I do not inwardly burn? <sup>30</sup>If I must boast, I will boast of the things that show my weakness. <sup>31</sup>The God and Father of the Lord Jesus, who is to be praised forever, knows that I am not lying. <sup>32</sup>In Damascus the governor under King Aretas had the city of the Damascenes guarded in order to arrest me. <sup>33</sup>But I was lowered in a basket from a window in the wall and slipped through his hands.】

**Feeble hearts stricken by panic: disheartened or discouraged spirit is an internally bred harmful nature!** Satan attacks Christians with every means and every affliction to dishearten them! What is its reason? It afflicts on Christians with all sorts of adversaries and hardships to induce complaints and bitterness against the Lord with the purpose of distancing people from their Lord!

### II. The key to overcoming adversities is to use the surpassing power from God. [2Co 4:

<sup>7</sup>But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from

God and not from us. <sup>8</sup>We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; <sup>9</sup>persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. <sup>10</sup>We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body.】

Once the Lord's surpassing power is in us, we will be naturally strong and courageous!  
**Apostle Paul was and still is a living example of living under the canopy of God's surpassing power: having been severely tortured by Satan, he kept his courage without losing heart or despair and there had been no grudge in him that offends God!**

**III. The key to overcoming adversities is to hold on to the eternal crown reserved in the heavenly realm. 【2Co 4: <sup>14</sup>because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in his presence. ... <sup>17</sup>For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.】**

**Christians can see the most precious eternal glory reserved for them!** The contexts immediately preceding **2Co 4: 16** manifested Paul's firm faith that he, with the other saints, will be raised up with Jesus in God's presence and reign with Christ forever! The verse immediately following **2Co 4: 16** manifested Paul's firm faith that "our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all".

- 1) As God's surpassing **power** is inside Paul, this power kept Paul from losing heart and courage!
- 2) As God's supreme and eternal **glory** is inside Paul, this glory kept Paul's faith and determination!

**How** can we own the same surpassing **power** of Paul's that allow us to perceive our extremely valuable and everlasting **glory**?

**IV. The ultimate key to living a wonderful life is to put our faith in the Gospel. 【2Co 4: <sup>3</sup>And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. <sup>4</sup>The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. <sup>5</sup>For we do not preach ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, and ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup>For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light**

shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. <sup>7</sup>But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. **Rom 1:16** I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. **1Co 1:18** For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.】

**Wholeheartedly have faith in the Gospel, which is the mighty power of God!**

This faith in the Gospel enables Christians to **possess** this all-surpassing **power** from God that is the treasure stored in jars of clay.

This faith in the Gospel enables Christians to **see** what Paul referred to as "our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal **glory** that far outweighs them all".

Christians' life rooted in the Gospel sprouts individuals that surpass the tier manifested by Elijah – unyielding, faithful, courageous, marching forward, bearing no bitterness against the Lord, and ultimately to the extent of fighting the good fight, finishing the race, and keeping the faith!

Faith, simply have faith in the mighty power the Gospel can generate exploding power in each of us as a clay jar, bestowing us power to overcome Satan's attacks! Everyone who have faith in the Gospel will receive his reserved crown in the heavenly kingdom!
