🔗Sermon: Be Up for The Storms

I. Anywhere in Life Without Storms?

1. Peter and I : v.28-29 Although the waves were roaring, as Peter saw it was Jesus, waves of emotions surged inside of him and he couldn't wait to get to Jesus. Peter's faith was pure, persistent, courageous, and dared to walk out and start an adventure.
2. Jesus and I : v.30-31 Jesus is always full of love and compassion. Jesus accepts us just as we are. He reaches out to us right away. Jesus may have allowed storms in our life to draw us to know Him, get near to Him, experience Him and have Him.

3. Storms and I : Each and every storm is a wakeup call and enables us to face the reality about my relationship with God, with myself, with other people, even with the devil. Life, does need storms (with God's permission).

II. Anywhere in Life Without Jesus ?

1. Know Ourselves : During a storm, what did it expose and reveal? Are we 'wood, hay, stubble' or 'gold, silver, precious stones'? Do we hold fast to faith or fall apart at once? Are we looking forward to heavenly kingdom or desperate in despair? How can we have a breakthrough in faith, to grow, be strong, and overcome the world? Please call Heavenly 119 for greater faith, deeper faith and genuine faith.

2. Heavenly 119 : This is our Jesus—He reached out to Peter right away. Our Lord loves us so much. He never hangs up, ignores our call, or despises our SOS. He replies and rescues at once. Let's learn from Peter, call to Jesus: "Lord, save me." Then you'll experience "Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed you".

3. Hold Tight to Jesus : At every critical moment, out of love and mercy, Jesus reached out his mighty hand and caught us immediately. Let's practice this together: to know Jesus more and more, getting nearer to Jesus, trust Jesus wholeheartedly, honor Jesus no matter what, and obey Jesus with full confidence. Hold tight to Jesus, never let go.

4. Adventure with God : In your life, how often will you face storms or go through fire and water? How often will you be able to step-out-to-adventure? The point is, would you dare to take an adventure with Jesus? Would you dare to start a new journey with our Lord? Would you dare to entrust all your time, talents, relationships, family, kids, finance.....your whole life into the hands of Jesus? Today, do you dare to start a little adventure for the sake of our loving Lord? Jesus knows your heart. Our gift to God is measured by what we have.
