🎙️ Sermon: Our Life Can Be So Wonderful (II)

The Lord has bestowed on us a power that can surpass any challenge; it is the surpassing power from God. There are six connotations in this surpassing power from God!

I. It is God's power! 【[Neh 9:32](#) "Now therefore, O our God, the great, mighty and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love, do not let all this hardship seem trifling in your eyes--the hardship that has come upon us, upon our kings and leaders, upon our priests and prophets, upon our fathers and all your people, from the days of the kings of Assyria until today.】

His power is above men, above all things, above spiritual realm, and all tiers of power! His power is paramount and ultimately absolute, intangible by all concrete forms of

material or all powers humans can conceive! His mighty power is way beyond our imagination!

II. Free us from being ensnared! 【[2Co 7:5](#) For when we came into Macedonia, this body of ours had no rest, but we were harassed at every turn--conflicts on the outside, fears within.】

"Troubles are round us on every side" : being pressed, extruded, afflicted, and surrounded by trouble.

The ability of breaking out from enclosure enables us to overcome the siege laid about us and reverse the advantages held by Satan, break through the surrounding brass walls and iron bastions set around us!

III. Inwardly perplexed, but not in despair!

"Perplexed" : in extreme despair, disheartening, and scared to the point of giving up hope!

Moses: predicament in the waste land on the shore of the Red Sea.

Paul: challenges posed by the many spiritual and societal problems present in the Church in Corinth.

After momentary setback and disheartening, God's power brought them hope that enabled them to get themselves together again, and refreshed their wills and determination to engage in the battle against confronting difficulties and overcome Satan's snares!

IV. Keep us accompanied without becoming alone! 【[Act 26: 14](#) We all fell to the ground,

and I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, 'Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.' ¹⁵"Then I asked, 'Who are you, Lord?' "'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting,' the Lord replied. ¹⁶Now get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you to appoint you as a servant and as a witness of what you have seen of me and what I will show you. ¹⁷I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles. I am sending you to them ¹⁸to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'】

Even when pursued, captured, and persecuted Jesus assures His disciples of His presence with them at all times! Jesus always fight for His disciples! If we have a part in Jesus' pain we will in the same way have a part in His glory!

Jesus loves us to the extent that He would die for us, He is the everlasting God and He will never leave us unaccompanied, He will always be our strength! The power from Jesus that is in us, that is, the power of God, is definitely beyond our imagination! The power of God can enable us to regain strength and reengage in combat in all kinds of frustration and win the battle!
