🎙️ **Sermon: When I feel that the LORD has left me**

While the Lord is making a covenant with His people through Moses at the top of Mount Sinai, His people at the foot of the mountain is quick at turning away from the LORD's commandment. The LORD's anger burned against His people and was about to kill them in the mountains and to wipe them off the face of the earth, God gave up guiding them ...

Round one: the Lord postpones His contemporary judgement and bestows on us peace we enjoy.

Aaron took the gold ornaments offered by the Israelites and made it into an idol cast in the shape of a calf, the Lord bursts out with anger and was about to wipe them off the face of the earth. And the LORD said to Moses "they are a stiff-necked people. Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them. Then I will make you into a great nation."

But Moses sought the favor of the LORD his God for 1) the people whom the Lord brought out of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand, 2) the LORD's name and mercy in the eyes of the Egyptians, 3) the LORD's covenant with Abraham. **【Exo 32:** ¹⁰Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them. Then I will make you into a great nation." ¹¹But Moses sought the favor of the LORD his God. "O LORD," he said, "why should your anger burn against your people, whom you brought out of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand? ¹²Why should the Egyptians say, 'It was with evil intent that he brought them out, to kill them in the mountains and to wipe them off the face of the earth'? Turn from your fierce anger; relent and do not bring disaster on your people. ¹³Remember your servants Abraham, Isaac and Israel, to whom you swore by your own self: 'I will make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and I will give your descendants all this land I promised them, and it will be their inheritance forever.'"]

As Moses went down from the mountain, he threw the tablets out of his hands breaking them to pieces at the foot of the mountain, he burned and grounded the gold calf, and reproached Aaron, he also commanded the Levites to kill their brother, friend and neighbor. **【Exo 32:29** Then Moses said, "You have been set apart to the LORD today, for you were against your own sons and brothers, and he has blessed you this day."】

To have our prayers reach the LORD, our assurance is not our good deed but the words of the Lord. **【Dan 9:** ²in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood

from the Scriptures, according to the word of the LORD given to Jeremiah the prophet, that the desolation of Jerusalem would last seventy years. ³So I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with him in prayer and petition, in fasting, and in sackcloth and ashes. ... ¹⁹O Lord, listen! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, hear and act! For your sake, O my God, do not delay, because your city and your people bear your Name." **1Jn 5:14** This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. **】**

Round two: close the eternal judgement, and awarding people with eternal life.

Moses pleaded to the LORD that the LORD forgive the people at the cost of his own life. **【Exo 32:** ³¹So Moses went back to the LORD and said, "Oh, what a great sin these people have committed! They have made themselves gods of gold. ³²But now, please forgive their sin--but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written." ³³The LORD replied to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against me I will blot out of my book. ³⁴Now go, lead the people to the place I spoke of, and my angel will go before you. However, when the time comes for me to punish, I will punish them for their sin." **】**

The LORD exerts his righteous judgement preceded by ample time for his people to repent! **【2Pe 3:9** The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. **】**

The LORD not only gives us our daily peace but also eternal heavenly peace and life, the heavenly kingdom is the most precious pearl everyone looks for. **【1Jn 2:17** The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever. **Mat 16:26** What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? **13:** ⁴⁵"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. ⁴⁶When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it. **】**

Round three: the LORD walks with me.

The LORD urged Moses to lead the Israelites to go up to the promised land, but the LORD will not go along, is this good or bad?

Moses said to the LORD that while he was given the mission of leading these people, but the LORD have not revealed to him whom the LORD will send with him. Though Moses had found favor with the LORD he pleaded to the LORD to teach him His ways so he may know Him and continue to find favor with Him; he also pleaded that the LORD go with him! **【Exo 33:** ¹Then the LORD said to Moses, "Leave this place, you

and the people you brought up out of Egypt, and go up to the land I promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants.' ²I will send an angel before you and drive out the Canaanites, Amorites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. ³Go up to the land flowing with milk and honey. But I will not go with you, because you are a stiff-necked people and I might destroy you on the way." ... ¹²Moses said to the LORD, "You have been telling me, 'Lead these people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. You have said, 'I know you by name and you have found favor with me.' ¹³If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you. Remember that this nation is your people." ¹⁴The LORD replied, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." **】**

Christ Jesus' symbolic name is Immanuel, God with us, how do we experience God's presence? The key is to be an individual who is after the LORD's heart, earnestly pray to the LORD for His Presence!

Round four: God walks with us.

Moses bundled himself with the people and pleaded for God's Presence go with them, having gained God's pleasure, the LORD committed to go with them!

【Exo 33: ¹⁵Then Moses said to him, "If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here. ¹⁶How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with your people unless you go with us? What else will distinguish me and your people from all the other people on the face of the earth?" ¹⁷And the LORD said to Moses, "I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name." **】**

A man of the Spirit bundled with general population prayed to the LORD. **【Rom 9:3** For I could wish that I myself were cursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, those of my own race, **Neh 1:6** let your ear be attentive and your eyes open to hear the prayer your servant is praying before you day and night for your servants, the people of Israel. I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's house, have committed against you. **Ezr 9:6** and prayed: "O my God, I am too ashamed and disgraced to lift up my face to you, my God, because our sins are higher than our heads and our guilt has reached to the heavens." **】**

The content of one's prayer is crucial, the spiritual status of the one who prays is even more important, many good examples can be found in the books written by Paul! **【Act 19:** ¹⁵One day the evil spirit answered them, "Jesus I know, and I know about Paul, but who are you?" ¹⁶Then the man who had the evil spirit jumped on them and overpowered them all. He gave them such a beating that they ran out of the house naked and bleeding. **】**

God has his rule in bestowing blessings: first, He finds a man of Spirit, then, through this man He gives blessings, commands, and changes!

Round five: The LORD shows His glory and compassion

Moses pleaded to the LORD for showing to him His glory, the LORD put Moses in a cleft in the rock and cover him with His mighty hand when the LORD's glory passes by, allowing Moses to see only His back; but the LORD's face must not be seen. **【Exo 33:18-19, 34:6** And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, **】** The greatest glory of the LORD is His mercy!

Goodness: signifies the LORD's kindness and perfection.

Kindness: signifies the LORD's grace that general humans do not deserve! The LORD is abounding in love and faithfulness.

Mercy: love and forgiveness, the LORD let sinners who deserves punishment go quite without punishment! The LORD is slow to anger and acquitting the guilty completely!
