**1Jn 3:16**

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

**Sermon: Revelations of Love III – Sacrificial Love**

What kind of love is selfless and loving?

Why would people ought to love so?

And how can we imitate Jesus as He presents the selfless love to the world?

**I. What sacrificial love is:**

- a. To sacrifice and to give oneself all for them. **[Phl 2:6-8.** <sup>6</sup> Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; <sup>7</sup> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross!
- b. To honor people by making oneself as a humble servant serving them. **[Phl 2:7** rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.]
- c. To respect whatever the choice that the others have made. **[Jhn 1:12** Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God. ] **[Luk 23:34** Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.]
- d. To be eagerly concerned about people. **[Phl 2:4** not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. ] **[Isa 53:2-10.** <sup>2</sup> He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him. <sup>3</sup> He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem. <sup>4</sup> Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. <sup>6</sup> We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. <sup>7</sup> He was oppressed and

afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. <sup>8</sup> By oppression and judgment he was taken away. Yet who of his generation protested? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of my people he was punished. <sup>9</sup> He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth. <sup>10</sup> Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the Lord makes his life an offering for sin, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the Lord will prosper in his hand. **】**

- e. To thoroughly obey God. **【Mak 8:31-33. <sup>31</sup>** He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. <sup>32</sup> He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. <sup>33</sup> But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns." **】**
- f. To be diligent. **【Jhn 5:16-17. <sup>16</sup>** So, because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jewish leaders began to persecute him. <sup>17</sup> In his defense Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working." **】**
- g. To be both righteous and merciful. **【Jhn 3:16** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **】**

## II. The great blessings that come with the sacrificial love

God receives glory and people get saved.

Blessing one: having peace in mind. **【1Jn 3:20-21. <sup>20</sup>** If our hearts condemn us, we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything. <sup>21</sup> Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God **】**

Blessing two: God listens to their prayers. **【1Jn 3:22-23. <sup>22</sup>** and receive from him anything we ask, because we keep his commands and do what pleases him. <sup>23</sup> And this is his command: to believe in the name of

his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us. **】**

Blessing three: God will be with you, that you are able to walk faithfully with God! **【1Jn 3:24** The one who keeps God's commands lives in him, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us. **】** **【1Jn 4:12** No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. **】** **【Jhn 15:7-8. <sup>7</sup>** If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. **v.10** If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. **v.12** My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. **】**

## III. The secret and the key to presenting sacrificial love in your life:

1. In Jhn ch15:1-17, we should be connected to Jesus all the time for He is the true vine and we are the branches. We remain in Him and He in us that we can bear fruit and be even more fruitful.
  - First, rouse yourself to accept Jesus.
  - Second, inspire yourself to practice loving each other.
  - Third, keep calling on God!
2. To enjoy the glory of Jesus. **【Jhn 17:22** I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one **】** This glory means:
  - a. The mighty power, strength, and the glory that have overcome the world.
  - b. The glory of completing the salvation work which is the will of God.
  - c. Heavenly kingdom. **【Eph 1:11** In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will. **】**

May the Holy Spirit open your eyes that you can see this glory, **making yourself enjoy the practice of sacrificial love.** Therefore, call on God more and meditate His words more frequently.
3. Keep seeking the will of Jesus. **【Jhn 17:26** I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them." **】** **【Col 3:2-3. <sup>2</sup>** Set your minds

on things above, not on earthly things. <sup>3</sup>For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.】

God is with you whenever and wherever you practice the sacrificial love to one another, that your personality and life will be renewed and become premium once you start doing so. Moreover, it will significantly change and determine your whole life!
