🔗 Sermon: Six Blessings for You from Heaven

The five blessings from heaven are longevity, riches and good fame, welfare and peace, good character and moral, and eventual rest in peace at an old age. The sixth blessing on top of the five gifts is good fortune in the present time into eternity, fortune on fortune!

I. Six blessings for you:

Our Father the God has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ:

This grace is of heaven and eternity in nature, we received all sorts of great mercy, a new birth and a living hope through Jesus Christ's pity and mercy.

- 1. We are chosen** **【Eph 1:4** For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. **】**

The Lord selected and justified us, gave us the most glorious image; we are of the Lord's selection before the creation of the world transcending millennia of ages in His love; we were chosen through Christ Jesus.

- 2. We are adopted as God's sons:** **【Eph 1:** ⁵he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will-- ⁶to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. **】**

God gave us the privilege of becoming His sons allowing us to approach Him without veil, He shows his love for us by revealing His smiling face to us; we, being sons of glory, should glorify our Father the God.

- 3. We are pardoned of our sins through Jesus' blood:** **【Eph 1:** ⁷In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace ⁶that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. **】**

God pardoned us of our sins and transgressions and put away the power of sin, are marvelous salvations.

- 4. The mystery of God's will is made known to us:** **【Eph 1:** ⁹And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, ¹⁰to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment--to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ. **】**

God made known to us the path we should follow in world, and we are revealed of His eternal plan, God's will and revelation is invincible!

- 5. We have a part in the heritage:** **【Eph 1:** ¹¹In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, ¹²in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. **】**

Being servants of the Lord Christ, the Lord will give us the reward of the heritage, which is unshakable and everlasting glorious.

- 6. We are sealed with the Holy Spirit:** **【Eph 1:** ¹³And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession--to the praise of his glory. **】**

The Lord bestows on us the Holy Spirit as a mark and a guarantee that we may glorify the Lord; we receive the Holy Spirit through truth.

II. The entrance to receiving the blessings: **【Eph 1:**

¹⁷I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit

of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. ¹⁸I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints,】

The crucial key is praying to the Lord for granting us the wisdom for acknowledging the Lord, for revealing His will to us, and for opening our eyes.

1. **Receive the calling for hope** (in the past): enabling us to know the hope we may have upon receiving His calling. We want to be able to appreciate our brand new identity and honor, so that we may feel assured and secured with the awarding with the new identity and honor.
2. **Possess the glorious heritage** (in the future): the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints through His calling, and we may appreciate how precious the eternal heavenly crown is.
3. **We have the power of resurrection** (in the present time) 【**Eph 1:** ¹⁹and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength, ²⁰which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,】

Don't overlook our mighty power of resurrection, it overcomes death and all adversities; just keep our eyes on the eternal heavenly kingdom.
