### 🔗 Sermon: Keeping All Things Well in Hand

Walking on the water shows us that He takes full control of it! Everything is in His hands!  
The good news is: Jesus is willing to share this mastery with us!

## I. The key to mastering it all: firmly believe in Jesus

**[Matt 14:28]** "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water."

**29** "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. **30** But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" **24** and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it.]

With God all things are possible! But one must draw with faith! "Little faith" is the biggest problem of human beings. The grace that controls all is to be drawn with great faith.

## II. Just look at Jesus, refuse to look at the storm

**[Matt 14:31]** Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"]

Q: Why did Peter's confidence not increase but decrease when he walked on the water?

A: Look at the wrong place ~ look at the wind and look at the waves. **Matt 14:30**

Q: How to get out of the shackles of little faith?

A: Look at Jesus but not the storm. Look at the power of Jesus, but not the power of the storm.

Use the "substitution method": when suffering and disaster come, just look at Jesus, think of Jesus, and declare the promise of Jesus!

Every day, not only think more but also read more about God's promises, God's way and praise God often.

When adversity comes, turn to God directly. To look at God, not to look at the wind and waves. Don't be frightened by them!

Refer to the Bible verses and hymns of promise from God.

## III. Be full of faith in God and stay away from arrogance

### **[Numbers 14:22-24]**

**22** not one of those who saw my glory and the signs I performed in Egypt and in the wilderness but who disobeyed me and tested me ten times—  
**23** not one of them will ever see the land I promised on oath to their ancestors. No one who has treated me with contempt will ever see it. **24** But because my servant Caleb has a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly, I will bring him into the land he went to, and his descendants will inherit it.]

Q: Why does experiencing and seeing miracles not necessarily give people confidence?

A: Despising God.

Q: Do you want to return from despising God?

A: The key to fully believing in God is to humble yourself in front of Lord and fear God.

Q: Why do people despise God?

A: Arrogance! In the heart of proud people, God is very weak and it's strong enough for themselves. Therefore, the faith in God is very small, and becomes the naturally "little faith"!

Q: How do you know if your confidence is big or small? (Many Christians do not know the actual size of their faith)

A: What is your attitude toward God? What is your attitude towards those around you? What is your attitude towards the suffering that you are experiencing?

## ● The Way Out of Pride: Return! i. Turning the vision to God

From appreciating yourself to appreciating God.  
From counting your own great deeds to counting  
God's great deeds.

From believing in yourself to believing in God.  
From respecting yourself to respecting God.

## ii. From critical to appreciation

Identify right from wrong, but don't become  
critical

Redirection of the attitude and thoughts:  
Improve the appreciation to God and people  
around! In this way, criticism will become  
discernment, and you will be far away from  
unconscious self-esteem and be controlled by  
criticism.

Faith in God → control everything

Little faith in God → sinking, sinking down,  
extinction

It was not the storm that defeated Peter, but Peter's  
little faith that defeated himself.

It was not the greatness of the Canaanites and the  
strong walls that defeated the Israelites, but the little  
faith of the Israelites defeated themselves!

### The way to be confident:

- a. It is to believe, to believe boldly, to turn to, to feel,  
to see God and God's grace!
- b. Humble yourself before the Lord, magnify God,  
fear God, believe with all your heart, and discard  
all doubts!
