### 🔗 Sermon: The Blessing for the Last Days

There will be terrible times in the apocalypse!  
 When we are about to face the calamities and disasters in the end of the world, Jesus will grant us the surpassing **grace and peace** that can help us defeat and overcome those suffering!  
 How to possess it?

#### I. Peace

Peace provides a fully **sense of security**, making you feel safe, peaceful, harmonious, delighted, and blissful.

Without peace in mind, people's hearts will be full of fears, worries, negativity, loneliness, helplessness, and hopelessness. Fear will take over you and stick with you in the rest of your life!

Shutting down your senses is a way to paralyze yourself and to be numb. That's not peace but deceiving yourself. All that glitters is not gold!

**Only Jesus can bestow the great peace upon people!**

#### II. Grace

Grace is what we do not deserve and are incapable of getting it by ourselves. Nevertheless, God accommodate us **all what we need** in every way! The grace God grants us is like a jigsaw puzzle. We will be surprised and astonished once reasoning out the solution to the puzzle!

What makes us feel more amazed is that we will become blessings representatives according to Gal 3:8. Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith and

announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you."

Who can deliver this kind of grace and peace?

Gal 1:3 Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

How will God help us to receive the abundant grace and peace?

Gal 1:4 who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father.

### III. The path to having grace and peace

Who can possess the grace and peace to get away from the present evil world?

First, believe in Jesus. Gal 2:16 know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.

Secondly, Obey the Holy Spirit. Gal 5:16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness. Gal 5:25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. Gal 6:8 Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

**A. Follow the guidelines of the Holy Spirit** instructs mindfully in our daily lives.

#### a. Love your neighbors as yourself

Gal 5:13-15, <sup>13</sup> You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love. <sup>14</sup> For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." <sup>15</sup> If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

#### b. Be away from the lust of the flesh

Gal 5:16-24, <sup>16</sup> So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. <sup>17</sup> For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under

the law. <sup>19</sup> The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; <sup>20</sup> idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions <sup>21</sup> and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. <sup>24</sup> Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

**c. Be the new creation**

**Gal 6:14-16,** <sup>14</sup> May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which<sup>a</sup> the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. <sup>15</sup> Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is the new creation. <sup>16</sup> Peace and mercy to all who follow this rule—to the Israel of God. **Gal 6:3-4,** <sup>3</sup> If anyone thinks they are something when they are not, they deceive themselves. <sup>4</sup> Each one should test their own actions. Then they can take pride in themselves alone, without comparing themselves to someone else. **Gal 6:8** Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

**B. Confront what is proved wrong by the Holy Spirit and obey.**

**1Jn 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. **Isa 1:18** “Come now, let us settle the matter,” says the Lord. “Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.

**C. When sadness comes to call, seize God’s promise revealed by the Holy Spirit.**

**Psm 37:5** Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this. **Phl 4:6-7,** <sup>6</sup> Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which transcends all

understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

People may ask, why does a Christian have that kind of peace and grace? How can they be so peaceful, brave, and relaxed even facing great difficulties?

The answer to the question is simple. Because they walk with the Holy Spirit, believing in the promise of God. Not only do they love their neighbors, walk away from the lust of the flesh, but also long for being the new creation. They have put off the old self and have put on the new self, having the same mindset as Jesus Christ!
