### 🔗 Sermon: Broaden The Whole New Horizons

The Bible has shown to us that when we are resurrected with Christ, our values will be completely different from those of the past in our vision, perspective, and heart pursuits and cares!

#### I. A new perspective is to see everything from eternity and heavenly kingdom

##### Matthew 16:24-26

<sup>24</sup>Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. <sup>25</sup>For whoever wants to save their life<sup>a</sup> will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. <sup>26</sup>What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?"

##### Matthew 18:8-9

<sup>8</sup>If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into eternal fire. <sup>9</sup>And if your eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye than to have two eyes and be thrown into the fire of hell.

The new perspective is the vision of seeing the earth from heaven and valuing this life from the position of eternity. The new perspective and

vision is: the perspective and vision of standing in eternity and heaven.

1. From "eternity" to see "the life on earth"
2. From the perspective of "heaven" to see "the wealth, glory, power, fame, and status of the world..."
3. From the "identity of the son of God" to see "the son of man"
4. From "heavenly home" to see the "earthly home"
5. From "God's vision" to see the "success and failure, gain and loss, birth and death, blessing and misfortune"
6. Using "truth" to see "the rules, philosophy, and all things in the world."
7. Seeing "suffering, unsolved pain" through "the Cross (God's sacrifice of Love for Me)"

How can we have great faith in God's promises?

#### II. A new perspective determines "the life on earth and eternity"

Q: Who would listen to God's Words and live it out?

Q: Whose faith is based on a solid rock like a wise man?

**It is the person who sees everything on earth with the eyes of heaven, the thinking of heaven, and the truth revealed by God!**

This perspective, this vision, **comes from what you really believe in what the Bible reveals: eternal life, the kingdom of heaven!**

#### III. Four tips for having a new perspective,

1. Ask God for "the spirit of wisdom revelation" Ephesians 1:17-19
2. Kneel down and cry out to God Ephesians 3:14-21
3. Seriously Know God's Revelation ~ The Bible, Know the Truth God Reveals You. Psalms 19:7-11
4. With those who have the perspective and vision of heaven. Heb.10:23-25
5. Identify the truth, identify God

A beautiful new perspective in truth will make you stand on **the ultimate glorious, highest-level eternity. Face every day with joy and happiness**, enjoy the new life, smile at this life, and **walk toward eternity with hope and motivation!**
