#### ☞Sermon: When The Storms of Life Are Raging

## I. Tempests in our lifetime **Jhn 6:18-21, Mat 14:27,33**

- 1. Flares up suddenly:** Such unexpected gigantic and formidable tempests happen in everyone's lifetime that appear to engulf you. Are you now submerged in a wavy storm and you are trying to grasp a life buoy? Our Father the God never assured us of a smooth and cozy life, instead, He shows us and make us go through the fact that He is the Lord of all tempests and He can calm down any tempest!
- 2. Rouse yourselves: Jhn 6:20,21; Mat 14:31,33**
  - (1) Be quick in hearing:** Listen to Jesus' voice saying "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." when you are inside a tempest, when you're afraid, or lonely, or in a critical situation, or in desperation.
  - (2) Be quick in seeing:** Stop focusing on military confrontations in the Strait, or the ups and downs of stock prices, or uncertainties in your romance; instead, move your vision on Jesus, and only Jesus, He is breaking through the wavy waters toward you to your rescue!
  - (3) Be quick in grasping:** Stretch out your arm and grasp quickly and tightly onto the most powerful hands of Jesus'. You have to first free up your hands from what you're now grasping so that your freed hands may be turned to Jesus through prayers, worship and proclamations!
  - (4) Be quick in accepting: [Jhn 6:21]** As soon as Jesus boarded the boat two miracles happened: the wind and rolling waves instantly went down and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading. Accept Jesus into your life, this is your shortcut to happiness, security, and perpetuity!
  - (5) Worship: [Mat 14:33]** Prostrating yourself to the Lord is a manifestation of humbleness, faith, reverence, thanksgiving, and action. Don't overlook or miss any Sunday Worship, or personal bow down and worship!

## II. Tempests in the last days **[Mak 13:29, 31-33]**

- 1. It's here already:** It will not get better tomorrow, the alarm bell will not stop ring, disasters will not disappear, prophecies are coming true. Jesus told us that "No one knows about that day or hour, ... Be on guard! Be alert!". The last days are very close, are we invited but not chosen? **[Mat 20:16]** "So the last will be first, and the first will be last." **22:14** "For many are invited, but few are chosen." ]
- 2. We are bound to win:**
  - (1) Observe carefully: [Mak 13:29]** Stop

looking at the worldly Sodom and Gomorrah, instead, look firmly at the prophecies recorded in the Holy Bible, look with the perspective of the heavenly kingdom, and look from the battle line of the last days: look soberly, intently, carefully, and alarmingly!

- (2) **Listen attentively: 【Mak 13:31】** Jesus clearly declared "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away." Make Lord's words, His promises, consolation, wisdom your daily assistance, power, guidance, and victory, listen attentively!
- (3) **Be on guard! Be alert!: 【Mak 13:32, 33】** Jesus stressed on remaining alerted 16 times for this is a generation filled with confusion, stupidity, impudicity, and evil. Therefore, the church, fellowship, group, inter-relationships, services, and preaching are of vital importance through which we may progress together daily via offering advice, encouragement, keeping watching, providing support and shelter with the goal of winning the final battle!
- (4) **Plead:【Mak 13:32, 33】** Simply by means of praying we can win, incessant praying keep us winning continuous victory; as long as we persist in praying with one mind we can confront any storm in the final days without fear. We can sing triumphal anthem in the last days, Hallelujah!
