II. Water pours in— hiding the metaphor of

1. After drinking the well water, one will be thirsty again.
2. Drink the living water and no longer be thirsty in spirit.

III. Purification related to the water – turning the darkness bright

1. Changing the subject because of sin
2. Directing the topic for righteousness

IV. Worship related to the water – reflecting on the past to uplift of the presence

1. Ancient worship focused on the spirits of the earth
2. Worship today in the Spirit and in truth
