🔗Scripture Reading:

1 Corinthians 11

22You can eat and drink in your own homes. It seems that you think God's church is not important. You embarrass those who are poor. What can I say? Should I praise you? No, I cannot praise you for this.

23The teaching I gave you is the same that I received from the Lord: On the night when the Lord Jesus was handed over to be killed, he took bread

24and gave thanks for it. Then he divided the bread and said, "This is my body; it is for you. Eat this to remember me."

25In the same way, after they ate, Jesus took the cup of wine. He said, "This cup represents the new agreement from God, which begins with my blood sacrifice. When you drink this, do it to remember me."

26This means that every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are telling others about the Lord's death until he comes again.

We do it for remembering the Lord!

I. Oblivious or not?

- 1. Forget Lord's salvation:** How precious is the Lord's salvation through the libation of His blood on the cross! How can we forget this salvation if not for being unaware of its significance? What does Jesus' mercy have to do with me?
- 2. Forget God's miraculous signs:** Our ability to put our faith in Jesus and enjoy His salvation, to come out of death into life again, is the most magnificent miracle, how can we forget the Lord's miracles so quickly as if they had no effects on us!
- 3. Forget about the Lord's calling:** We are each given a designated assignment from our heavenly Father; His laws and commissions had once been clear to us but now we have turned away from our first love and enthusiasm for spreading the Gospel! Can

we arouse in time to turn again to the Lord and take our positions?

- 4. Forget how unbearable we had been:** What is man that you keep me in mind? We were once slaves of sinful desires of our flesh and death is what we deserve; we were bought back and redeemed with Jesus' sacred blood because of His unsurpassable love for us! Do we remember what we used to be and how unforgivable we once were?

II. Bear in mind or not?

- 1. The hands with nail holes:**

John 20

25They told him, "We saw the Lord."

Thomas said, "That's hard to believe. I will have to see the nail holes in his hands, put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side. Only then will I believe it."

26A week later the followers were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. The doors were locked, but Jesus came and stood among them. He said, "Peace be with you!"

27Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here. Look at my hands. Put your hand here in my side. Stop doubting and believe."

28Thomas said to Jesus, "My Lord and my God!"

This pair of hands have delivered solace and healing to numerous people, yet these hands had been brutally and forcefully nailed to the cross. We should put these hands with nail holes in remembrance and must not repeatedly crucify Jesus by turning back to the world and embracing the taste of the pleasures of sin; we must not relive the old life that was under the power of Satan. We should focus on this paired of nailed hands and follow the guidance of the Lord along the righteous path leading to eternity.

- 2. Loving gaze:**

Luke 22

61Then the Lord turned and looked into Peter's eyes. And Peter remembered what the Lord had said, "Before the rooster crows in the morning, you will say three times that you don't know me."

62Then Peter went outside and cried bitterly.

Matthew 26:50 Jesus answered, "Friend, do the thing you came to do." Then the men came and grabbed Jesus and arrested him.

No betrayal, denial, running away, abandonment, ruthlessness, or ungratefulness can deny Jesus' loving gaze. Stop being cheated by Satan's accusation and lies, release yourself from deceitful entanglements

and turn to the Lord, just look at His loving gaze now!

3. **Precious blood:** hold in remembrance — Jesus' sacred blood can cleanse, heal, release, redeem, and revive us. The covenant Jesus made with us — there is no previous criminal record but only fresh restart, there is no too late but only to grasp the present, there is no conviction but the Book of Life, there is no gate to the inferno but only the path to the heavenly kingdom. These are only possible for the sake of the sacred blood of the Lamb!

4. **Jesus' expectation:**

1 Corinthians 11

18First, I hear that when you meet together as a church you are divided. And this is not hard to believe

19because of your idea that you must have separate groups to show who the real believers are!

Jesus' ultimate expectation from Christians is to have love for one another. The most damaging factor to the church is division or partisanship. Paul was agitated to outspoke: all would be in vain without love, no one can be admitted into the heavenly kingdom without love; without love the church may become a hiding place for thieves. Dear sisters and brothers in Christ, what Jesus wants from us is simple: love one another wholeheartedly, do it right away and start with our wording, actions, Jesus' nailed hands, loving gaze, and His sacred redeeming blood. We can love because the Lord loved us first!

☞ Practice the grand commandment in love — Have love for your neighbor as for yourself!

☞ Practice the grand mission in love — spread the Good News and deploy the 1+1 Action over the Easter.
