Mark 1:16-18 Jesus Chooses Some Followers

16 Jesus was walking by Lake Galilee. He saw Simon[a] and his brother Andrew. These two men were fishermen, and they were throwing a net into the lake to catch fish.

17 Jesus said to them, "Come, follow me, and I will make you a different kind of fishermen. You will bring in people, not fish."

18 So they immediately left their nets and followed Jesus.

John 21:18-19

18 The truth is, when you were young, you tied your own belt and went where you wanted. But when you are old, you will put out your hands, and someone else will tie your belt. They will lead you where you don't want to go."

19 (Jesus said this to show how Peter would die to give glory to God.) Then he said to Peter, “Follow me!”

Act 4:13,19,20

13 The Jewish leaders understood that Peter and John had no special training or education. But they also saw that they were not afraid to speak. So the leaders were amazed. They also realized that Peter and John had been with Jesus.

19 But Peter and John answered them, “What do you think is right? What would God want? Should we obey you or God?”

20 We cannot be quiet. We must tell people about what we have seen and heard.”

Sermon: Walk with God

Luke 22:61-62 Jesus Chooses Some Followers **61**

Then the Lord turned and looked into Peter’s eyes. And Peter remembered what the Lord had said, Before the rooster crows in the morning, you will say three times that you don’t know me.” **62** Then Peter went outside and cried bitterly.

John 21:20-22 Peter turned and saw the follower Jesus loved very much walking behind them. (This was the follower who had leaned against Jesus at the supper and said, “Lord, who is it that will hand you over?”) **21** When Peter saw him behind them, he asked Jesus, “Lord, what about him?” **22** Jesus answered, “Maybe I want him to live until I come. That should not matter to you. You follow me!”

Starting with Peter and Paul!

It is the level of power, the level of love, and the level of high wisdom. It is the level of "not caring about oneself, but caring about God and others."

Not concerned about one's own glory, feelings, or affirmation! Only concerned about God's glory, God's comfort, and God's praise!

Not concerned about one's own grievances, enmities, life and death, fortunes and losses, personal interests. Only concerned about the life and death, fortunes and losses, and salvation of others' souls.

Proverbs 10:12 Hatred causes arguments, but love overlooks all wrongs.

Genesis 3:6,16 The woman could see that the tree was beautiful and the fruit looked so good to eat. She also liked the idea that it would make her wise. So she took some of the fruit from the tree and ate it. Her husband was there with her, so she gave him some of the fruit, and he ate it. **16** Then God said to the woman, “I will cause you to have much trouble when you are pregnant. And when you give birth to children, you will have much pain. You will want your husband very much, but he will rule over you.”

Matthew 26:39 Then Jesus went on a little farther away from them. He fell to the ground and prayed, “My Father, if it is possible, don’t make me drink from this cup.[a] But do what you want, not what I want.”

Philippians 2:9 So God raised him up to the most important place and gave him the name that is greater than any other name.

James 3:17 But the wisdom that comes from God is like this: First, it is pure. It is also peaceful, gentle, and easy to please. This wisdom is always ready to help people who have trouble and to do good for others. This wisdom is always fair and honest.

1 Corinthians 2:15 We who have the Spirit are able to make judgments about all these things. But anyone without the Spirit is not able to make proper judgments about us.

I. It is the level at which our spirit walks with God Pro 10:12; Gen 3:6,16; Mat 26:39; Phl 2:9; Jas 33:17; 1Co 2:15

Let’s start our discussion with Peter and Paul: It is not: knowledge in vain, affirmation by the world, exalting oneself, pursuing one's dreams, being friends with the world, taking worldly view as perspective of values, standing at the level of the summit of worldly success! Instead, it is: the level of heavenly power, and the level of love.

The level of fear of God—the level of "do not do what I wish, but do in compliance with your will." The level of wisdom, the spiritual being’s level of understanding all things.

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit that the Spirit produces in a person’s life is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these kinds of things.

Luke 5:30-32 But the Pharisees and those who taught the law for the Pharisees began to complain to the followers of Jesus, “Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and other sinners?” **31** Jesus answered them, “It is the sick people who need a doctor, not those who are healthy. **32** I have not come to ask good people to change. I have come to ask sinners to change the way they live.”

John 8:5-12 The Law of Moses commands us to stone to death any such woman. What do you say we should do?” **6** They were saying this to trick Jesus. They wanted to catch him saying something wrong so that they could have a charge against him. But Jesus stooped down and started writing on the ground with his finger. **7** The Jewish leaders continued to ask him

their question. So he stood up and said, “Anyone here who has never sinned should throw the first stone at her.” 8 Then Jesus stooped down again and wrote on the ground. 9 When they heard this, they began to leave one by one. The older men left first, and then the others. Jesus was left alone with the woman standing there in front of him. 10 He looked up again and said to her, “Where did they all go? Did no one judge you guilty?” 11 She answered, “No one, sir.” Then Jesus said, “I don’t judge you either. You can go now, but don’t sin again.” 12 Later, Jesus talked to the people again. He said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never live in darkness. They will have the light that gives life.”

Mark 10:21-22 Jesus looked at the man in a way that showed how much he cared for him. He said, “There is still one thing you need to do. Go and sell everything you have. Give the money to those who are poor, and you will have riches in heaven. Then come and follow me.” 22 The man was upset when Jesus told him to give away his money. He didn’t want to do this, because he was very rich. So he went away sad.

Matthew 11:29 Accept my teaching. Learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will be able to get some rest.

Luke 20:20-26 So the Jewish leaders waited for the right time to get Jesus. They sent some men to him, who pretended to be sincere. They wanted to find something wrong with what Jesus said. (If they found something wrong, then they could hand him over to the governor, who had the authority to arrest him.) 21 So the men said to Jesus, “Teacher, we know that what you say and teach is true. It doesn’t matter who is listening—you teach the same to all people. You always teach the truth about God’s way. 22 Tell us, is it right for us to pay taxes to Caesar or not?” 23 But Jesus knew that these men were trying to trick him. He said to them, 24 “Show me a silver coin. Whose name and picture are on it?” They said, “Caesar’s.” 25 He said to them, “Then give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar, and give to God what belongs to God.” 26 The men were amazed at his wise answer. They could say nothing. They were not able to trick Jesus there in front of the people. He said nothing they could use against him.

Luke 23:33-35 They were led to a place called “The Skull.” There the soldiers nailed Jesus to the cross. They also nailed the criminals to crosses beside Jesus—one on the right and the other on the left. 34 Jesus said, “Father, forgive them. They don’t know what they are doing.” The soldiers threw dice to divide Jesus’ clothes between them. 35 The people stood there watching everything. The Jewish leaders laughed at Jesus. They said, “If he is God’s Chosen One, the Messiah, then let him save himself. He saved others, didn’t he?”

John 10:18 No one takes my life away from me. I give my own life freely. I have the right to give my life, and I have the right to get it back again. This is what the Father told me.”

James 3:17-18 But the wisdom that comes from God is like this: First, it is pure. It is also peaceful, gentle, and easy to please. This wisdom is always ready to help people who have trouble and to do good for others. This wisdom is always fair and honest. 18 People who work for peace in a peaceful way get the blessings that come from right living.

James 3:14-16 If you are selfish and have bitter jealousy in your hearts, you have no reason to boast. Your boasting is a lie that hides the truth. 15 That kind of “wisdom” does not come from God. That “wisdom” comes from the world. It is not spiritual. It is from the devil. 16 Where there is jealousy and selfishness, there will be confusion and every kind of evil.

James 4:1-4 Do you know where your fights and arguments come from? They come from the selfish desires that make war inside you. 2 You want things, but you don’t get them. So you kill and are jealous of others. But you still cannot get what you want. So you argue and fight. You don’t get what you want because you don’t ask God. 3 Or when you ask, you don’t receive anything, because the reason you ask is wrong. You only want to use it for your own pleasure. 4 You people are not faithful to God! You should know that loving what the world has is the same as hating God. So anyone who wants to be friends with this evil world becomes God’s enemy.

II. The level of walking with God must not be lost

1. Live in the noblest mindset **Gal 5:22-23**
2. Live in God's love **Luk 5:30-32; Jhn 8:5-12; Mak 10:21-22; Mat 11:29; Luk 20:20-26, 23:33-35; Jhn 10:18; Jas 3:17-18, 3:14-16, 4:1-4**

Matthew 15:3-12 Jesus answered, “And why do you refuse to obey God’s command so that you can follow those traditions you have? 4 God said, ‘You must respect your father and mother.’ [a] And God also said, ‘Whoever says anything bad to their father or mother must be killed.’ [b] 5 But you teach that a person can say to their father or mother, ‘I have something I could use to help you. But I will not use it for you. I will give it to God.’ 6 You are teaching them not to respect their father. So you are teaching that it is not important to do what God said. You think it is more important to follow those traditions you have. 7 You are hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he spoke for God about you: 8 ‘These people honor me with their words, but I am not really important to them. 9 Their worship of me is worthless. The things they teach are only human rules.’” 10 Jesus called the people to him. He said, “Listen and understand what I am saying. 11 It is not what people put in their mouth that makes them

wrong.[c] It is what comes out of their mouth that makes them wrong.” 12 Then the followers came to Jesus and asked, “Do you know that the Pharisees are upset about what you said?”

John 11:48 If we let him continue doing these things, everyone will believe in him. Then the Romans will come and take away our Temple and our nation.”

Matthew 13:55-58 Isn't he just the son of the carpenter we know? Isn't his mother's name Mary, and aren't his brothers James, Joseph, Simon, and Judas? ⁵⁶And don't all his sisters still live here in town? How is he able to do these things?” ⁵⁷So they had a problem accepting him. But Jesus said to them, “People everywhere give honor to a prophet, but in his own town or in his own home a prophet does not get any honor.” ⁵⁸Jesus did not do many miracles there, because the people did not believe in him.

Matthew 11:17, 19 ‘We played flute music for you, but you did not dance; we sang a funeral song, but you were not sad.’

19 The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and people say, ‘Look at him! He eats too much and drinks too much wine. He’s a friend of tax collectors and other sinners.’ But wisdom is shown to be right by what it does.”

Luke 22:67 They said, “If you are the Messiah, then tell us that you are.” Jesus said to them, “If I tell you I am the Messiah, you will not believe me.

John 6:64 But some of you don't believe.” (Jesus knew the people who did not believe. He knew this from the beginning. And he knew the one who would hand him over to his enemies.)

1 Corinthians 13:1-3 I may speak in different languages, whether human or even of angels. But if I don't have love, I am only a noisy bell or a ringing cymbal. 2 I may have the gift of prophecy, I may understand all secrets and know everything there is to know, and I may have faith so great that I can move mountains. But even with all this, if I don't have love, I am nothing. 3 I may give away everything I have to help others, and I may even give my body as an offering to be burned. But I gain nothing by doing all this if I don't have love.

III. What is the biggest obstruction to getting into this level?

1. For the Pharisees, scribes, Jews:

pride **Mat 15:3-12**;
greed for properties **Jhn 11:48**;
negligence **Mat 13:55-58**;
indifference **Mat 11:17**;
crookedness **Mat 11:19**;
disbelief **Luk 22:67, Jhn 6:64**

2. According to **1Co 1-3**, the key is: there is no love!

3. According to comparing Eve and Jesus, the key is: honor oneself as great

IV. There are two core secrets to walking with God

1. Fear the Lord
2. Love your neighbor as yourself

Refer to the examples set by the seven great spiritual men: Abraham, Joseph, Moses, Isaiah, David, Peter, and Paul.

The knack to walking with God: Do one's best that is pleasing to the Lord; and refrain from doing things that is not pleasing to God. Don't underestimate how terrible it is living in the level of disobedience. Don't disdain the blessings of living in walking with God.

Live at the level of walking with God: glorify God all our life, live worthwhile, live joyfully, do not get tangled, rejoice often, get rid of self-pity and melancholy, get rid of complaining, laugh often, praise and laud instead of criticism and sarcasm, be kind and wise in heart, full of heavenly wisdom instead of darkness in heart, full of earthly wisdom, magnanimity, not calculating, not contending, angry, self-righteousness, insisting on the truth but not being stubborn, seeing through everything!

Those who are on the level of walking with God live with a noble heart, live with God's love ~ life reflects the glory of God, their lives are free, joyful, with fear of God, love for God and for people has fused in his soul!

This is the spiritual level we are striving for, and the reason we are pursuing this spiritual level!
