Sermon: A Year's Plan, A Day's Plan

I. Plan for a Lifetime

1. To be Protected: **Psalm 5:4-6, 9-10, 12; Isaiah 33:2; Zephaniah 3:5**

Psalm 5:4-6, 9-10

4 God, you don't want evil people near you. They cannot stay in your presence.

5 Fools cannot come near you. You hate those who do evil.

6 You destroy those who tell lies. Lord, you hate those who make secret plans to hurt others.

9 My enemies never tell the truth. They only want to destroy people. Their words come from mouths that are like open graves. They use their lying tongues to deceive others.

10 Punish them, God! Let them be caught in their own traps. They have turned against you, so punish them for their many crimes.

Psalm 5:12 Lord, when you bless good people, you surround them with your love, like a large shield that protects them.

Zephaniah 3:5 But the LORD is still in that city, and he continues to be good. He does not do anything wrong. He continues to help his people. Morning after morning he makes good decisions for them. Not a day passes without his justice. He never gives a decision that is crooked or is something to be ashamed of.

Isaiah 33:2 Lord, be kind to us. We have waited for your help. Give us strength every morning. Save us when we are in trouble.

God executes righteous judgment, and evildoers stumble because of their own schemes! God's grace surrounds His people like a shield, protecting them from enemies on all sides!

Every morning, God is our strength, revealing His righteousness!

2. To Find Joy: **Psalm 5:11; Psalm 42:5; Lamentations 3:22-23**

Psalm 5:11 (New American Standard Bible)

11 But rejoice, all who take refuge in You, Sing for joy forever! And may You shelter them, That those who love Your name may rejoice in You.

Psalm 42:5 Why am I so sad? Why am I so upset? I tell myself, "Wait for God's help! You will again be able to praise him, your God, the one who will save you." In my sadness I say, "I will remember you from here on this small hill, where Mount Hermon and the Jordan River meet."

Lamentations 3:22-23 We are still alive because the Lord's faithful love never ends.

23 Every morning he shows it in new ways! You are so very true and loyal!

Those who trust in the Lord find great joy and rejoicing, finding joy in the Lord.

God helps us with **a smiling face**, and joy is the fruit of the Holy Spirit, a sign of God's presence.

Every morning, God's love and mercy are renewed!
We can rejoice even in times of trouble!

3. To be Guided: **Psalm 5:8; Proverbs 3:3-4; Isaiah 50:4**

Psalm 5:8 Lord, show me your right way of living, and make it easy for me to follow. People are looking for my weaknesses, so show me how you want me to live.

Joshua 3:3-4 They gave orders to the people: "When you see the Levite priests carrying the Box of the Agreement of the Lord your God, follow them.

4 But do not follow too closely. Stay about 1000 yards behind them. You have not been here before, but if you follow them, you will know where to go."

Isaiah 50:4 The Lord GOD gave me the ability to teach, so now I teach these sad people. Every morning he wakes me and teaches me like a student.

God guides us in righteousness, leading us on the right path, and His path is straight before us! God guides us all the way, awakening us and guiding us on the path of righteousness!

Every morning, the Lord opens my ears to instruction and teaches me.

II. Planning for a Day

1. Morning Prayer: **Psalm 5:3; Psalm 57:8**

Psalm 5:3 Every morning, Lord, I lay my gifts before you and look to you for help. And every morning you hear my prayers.

Morning = the most urgent time;
Lay my requests = setting offerings neatly on the altar;

Psalm 57:8 Wake up, my soul! Harps and lyres, wake up, and let's wake the dawn!

Every morning, I wake with the dawn! I open my eyes to see Jesus and pray to the Lord!

2. Reverence for God: **Psalm 5:7, 4; Isaiah 50:4**

Psalm 5:7 But by your great mercy, I can enter your house. I can worship in your holy Temple with fear and respect for you.

Psalm 5:4 God, you don't want evil people near you. They cannot stay in your presence.

Isaiah 50:4 The Lord GOD gave me the ability to teach, so now I teach these sad people. Every morning he wakes me and teaches me like a student.

"I enter your house by your abundant love," relying on the Lord rather than myself!

"I worship in your holy temple with reverence," God dislikes evil deeds, and I detest sin too.

Every morning, I hear the word of God, using words to support others!

3. Love for God: **Psalm 5:11; John 14:21; Romans 8:28; 1 Corinthians 2:9**

Psalm 5:11 But rejoice, all who take refuge in You, Sing for joy forever! And may You shelter them, That those who love Your name may rejoice in You.

Romans 8:28 We know that in everything God works for the good of those who love him. These are the people God chose, because that was his plan.

1 Corinthians 2:9 But as the Scriptures say, "No one has ever seen, no one has ever heard, no one has ever imagined what God has prepared for those who love him."

Those who really love me are the ones who not only know my commands but also obey them. My Father will love such people, and I will love them. I will make myself known to them." (**John 14:21**)

"May those who love your name rejoice in you," Those who love God experience joy, witness God's presence, everything turns out for good, and they receive immense blessings!

Loving God = **obeying** God's word!

Life's plan: Rise early to pray, honor and love God.
