Luke 5:1-11

- 1 Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, and a crowd gathered around Him to hear the word of God.
- 2 He saw two boats at the shore; the fishermen had left them and were washing their nets.
- 3 Jesus got into one of the boats, which belonged to Simon, and asked him to push it out a little from the shore. Then He sat down and taught the people from the boat.
- 4 When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and let down the nets for a catch."
- 5 Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because You say so, I will let down the nets."
- 6 When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break.
- 7 So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.
- 8 When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"
- 9 For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken,
- 10 and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people."
- 11 So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed Him.
