🔗 **Scripture Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4**

1 “Look at my servant, whom I **strengthen** and **choose**, the one I **delight in!** I have given him my **Spirit**, and he will bring **justice** to all nations.
2 He will **not shout** or raise his voice in the streets.
3 He will **not break** a bruised reed or snuff out a flickering candle. He will faithfully bring justice.
4 He will **not give up** or lose heart until he brings justice to the earth. Even distant lands are waiting for his teaching.”

Sermon: Blessed to Be a Blessing - Pastor Hsu

What are my dreams? Who do I want to become?
 What choices matter most?

I. Being Blessed (Isaiah 42:1)

1. Chosen by God (Matthew 3:17; Ephesians 1:4; 1 Peter 2:9)

Matthew 3:17 And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.'

Ephesians 1:4 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Jesus was chosen by God. The Father said, “This is my beloved Son!”

Before the world was created, God chose us in Christ. We are God's chosen people!

You and I are God's children, friends, workers, and citizens of an eternal kingdom, and we will reign with Him!

2. Supported by God (Philippians 2:13; Hebrews 1:3)

Philippians 2:13 For it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.

Hebrews 1:3 The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

When Jesus was tempted by the devil and prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, the Father supported Him!

God works in us to give us the desire and ability to do His will, and He holds everything with His powerful hand.

3. Pleasing to God (Matthew 3:17; 17:5; Colossians 1:10)

Matthew 3:17 And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.'

17:5 While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!'

Colossians 1:10 So that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God.

When Jesus was baptized and at the Transfiguration, the Father said, “You are my beloved Son, and I am pleased with you!”

When we live and act in a way that pleases Jesus in everything, what great joy we have!

4. Filled with the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:16; Luke 11:13)

Matthew 3:16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him.

Luke 11:13 If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!

When Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit came down on Him, and His ministry was full of the Spirit's power!

The Father promised to give us "good gifts"—the Holy Spirit!

He fills us with the Holy Spirit and His power!

II. Being a Blessing to Others

1. Bringing Great Blessings (Isaiah 42:1, 3; 9:2; Luke 1:78-79)

Isaiah 42:1, 3 Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations.

3 A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out. In faithfulness he will bring forth justice.

9:2 The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned.

Luke 1:78-79 Because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace.

Jesus brings justice to the nations. He proclaims justice with truth, and the distant islands wait for God's teaching! People living in darkness and the shadow of death can see the true light and turn to it!

Through us, God brings His mercy, the morning light, and the path of peace to others!

2. Quiet and Gentle (Isaiah 42:2; Proverbs 13:3; Ecclesiastes 5:2)

Isaiah 42:2 He will not shout or cry out, or raise his voice in the streets.

Proverbs 13:3 Those who guard their lips preserve their lives, but those who speak rashly will come to ruin.

Ecclesiastes 5:2 Do not be quick with your mouth, do not be hasty in your heart to utter anything before God. God is in heaven and you are on earth, so let your words be few.

God's servant does not shout or raise his voice. Jesus refused the crowd's attempt to make Him king. He rode into Jerusalem on a donkey, stayed silent during His trial, and endured the cross!

Those who speak loudly and boastfully will face ruin; too many words lead to mistakes.

God is in heaven, and we are on earth, so we should speak less. God knows the truth, and He will speak in His time!

3. Merciful, Not Selfish (Isaiah 42:3; James 2:1-4)

Isaiah 42:3 A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out. In faithfulness he will bring forth justice;

James 2:1-4 My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favoritism.

2 Suppose a man comes into your meeting wearing a gold ring and fine clothes, and a poor man in filthy old clothes also comes in.

3 If you show special attention to the man wearing fine clothes and say, 'Here's a good seat for you,' but say to the poor man, 'You stand there' or 'Sit on the floor by my feet,'

4 have you not discriminated among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?"

Bruised reeds and flickering flames, the people who seem insignificant to others, are the ones Jesus cares for with deep compassion.

Widows, children, tax collectors, and sinners—Jesus never looked down on them. Instead, He actively showed them mercy and love!

While people often value wealth, power, beauty, and usefulness, the Bible reminds us not to judge by outward appearances. Because we fear and honor God, we should respect others and treat them with dignity and honor!

4. Patient and Not Discouraged (Isaiah 42:4; Hebrews 12:2-3)

Isaiah 42:4 He will not falter or be discouraged till he establishes justice on earth; in his teaching the islands will put their hope.

Hebrews 12:2-3 Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

God's servant does not lose heart or give up. Jesus endured criticism, attacks, and people's lack of faith, yet He never lost hope. He remained obedient to the Father, taught His disciples, and spread the gospel!

When we face hardship and lies, we should fix our eyes on Jesus. He is the author and finisher of our faith, who endured suffering. His victory is our victory!

Jesus' life was fully transparent, reflecting God's glory through His obedience, helping others see God. This is the most valuable way to live!

The prayers of the righteous can save Taiwan!
(Ezekiel 22:30; Genesis 18:26, 32)

Ezekiel 22:30 "I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one.

Genesis 18:26, 32 Then the Lord said, 'If I find fifty righteous people in the city of Sodom, I will spare the whole place for their sake.

32 Then he said, 'May the Lord not be angry, but let me speak just once more. What if only ten can be found there?' He answered, 'For the sake of ten, I will not destroy it.'
