12:5 If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan?

Sermon: Overcoming Life's Crises - Pastor Hsu

Why is my life so hard? Will tomorrow be better?

I. Greater Challenges, Stronger Shoulders: <u>Jeremiah 12:5; 2 Peter 1:10-11</u>

Jeremiah 12:5 If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan?

2 Peter 1:10-11 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, make every effort to confirm your calling and election. For if you do these things, you will never stumble, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Jeremiah saw wicked people living in peace and success. He wondered, "Where is God? Where is justice? How long will this suffering last?"

It seemed like God didn't comfort him but instead warned that even greater challenges were coming.

Jeremiah had to take on heavier responsibilities. God was training him by allowing him to face great difficulties.

God has a bigger plan for you and me!

While we often hope for a smooth and peaceful life, God calls us to join His Kingdom work and face challenges without fear.

Are we willing to let go of our comfort and step out of our safe zone to boldly take on God's mission for us?

We need to actively and diligently prepare ourselves to fully enter God's Kingdom by:

- Growing in knowledge and understanding of how to love others
- Gaining wisdom and insight from God's truth
- II. Eternal Glory and Peaceful Hope: <u>Jeremiah</u>
 29:11; 2 Corinthians 4:17; Philippians 1:2829

<u>Jeremiah 29:11</u> For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.

<u>2 Corinthians 4:17</u> For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

Philippians 1:28-29 Without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved—and that by God. For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him.

From a human perspective, being exiled to a foreign land seemed like a disaster. The exiled people couldn't return home and appeared to have lost everything.

In contrast, those who stayed in Jerusalem seemed more fortunate.

But God made a surprising promise — the future hope wasn't for those who stayed but for those who were exiled!

God preserved the sacred temple vessels, protected the lives of His chosen people, and kept their faith alive in foreign lands.

As God's people, we need to see life from an eternal perspective.

It's better to lose temporary comforts if it means gaining eternal life!

Through challenges, we receive God's holiness, peace, and protection.

The Bible reminds us: *Our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all* (2 Corinthians 4:17). What we endure today is small compared to the amazing eternal glory God has prepared for us!

III. Courage Grows Stronger: Victory Through Faith: Jeremiah 26:20-23, 15; 1 Peter 1:7; Hebrews 11:34 Jeremiah 26:20-23, 15 Now Uriah son of Shemaiah from Kiriath Jearim was another man who prophesied in the name of the LORD; he prophesied the same things against this city and this land as Jeremiah did. 21 When King Jehoiakim and all his officials and officers heard his words, the king was determined to put him to death. But Uriah heard of it and fled in fear to Egypt.

22 King Jehoiakim, however, sent Elnathan son of Achbor to Egypt, and Elnathan brought Uriah back to King Jehoiakim, who had him struck down with a sword and his body thrown into the burial place of the common people.

23 But Jeremiah had been rescued from the hands of the king of Judah.

15 As for me, I am in your hands; do with me whatever you think is good and right.

<u>1 Peter 1:7</u> These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.

<u>Hebrews 11:34</u> quenched the fury of the flames and escaped the edge of the sword; whose weakness was turned to strength; and who became powerful in battle and routed foreign armies.

Jeremiah boldly delivered God's message, warning that the nation would be destroyed and exiled.

The king was furious, and the priests arrested Jeremiah and threw him into prison.

During that same time, another prophet, Uriah, received the same message from God and faced the same pressure. But unlike Jeremiah, Uriah chose fear—he ran away but was captured and killed.

Jeremiah, however, chose to be brave and stand firmly on God's side. God protected him because of his courage and faith.

Thoughts: Why was Jeremiah able to be brave and victorious?

He deeply understood God's calling! He constantly heard from God and encountered God!

He didn't give up on coming before God, and because of this, he was able to stand with God! This is the key to victory! It is through unceasing cries, being filled with truth, that we are supported!

Difficulties are meant to train our faith. Battles reveal our courage. As we practice bravery and strength, we experience that God is our strength and hope! This strengthens and encourages us, enabling us to respond courageously to the Lord!
