**13** Keep your servant also from willful sins; may they not rule over me. Then I will be blameless, innocent of great transgression.

**14** May these words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.

**II. Listen to & observe God's creation - Psalm 19:1-6, 8:3-9; Romans 1:19-20**

**Psalm 19:1-6** The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

**2** Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge.

**3** They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them.

**4** Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens God has pitched a tent for the sun.

**5** It is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, like a champion rejoicing to run his course.

**6** It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is deprived of its warmth.

**8:3-9** When I consider your heavens, the work of your

fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,

**4** what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?

**5** You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor.

**6** You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet:

**7** all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild,

**8** the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.

**9** Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

**Romans 1:19-20** Since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.

**20** For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.

### III. Read & meditate on God's Word – **Psalm 19:7-11**

**Psalm 19:7-11** The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple.

**8** The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes.

**9** The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever. The decrees of the Lord are firm, and all of them are righteous.

**10** They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the honeycomb.

**11** By them your servant is warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
