Sermon: When Hard Times Turn Into Blessings

I. God Gives Great Blessings and Abundance

1. A Life That Grows and Becomes Better (Isaiah 27:6a)

Our lives will be transformed and improved. We will grow in wisdom, character, and depth—becoming truly wonderful.

2. A Life Filled with Abundance (Isaiah 27:6b)

Like a tree planted in rich soil, we will take root, grow, bloom, and bear much fruit.

3. A Life That is Cared for and Protected (Isaiah 27:3-4)

God provides for us every moment, helping us grow beyond our limits and become mature.

He watches over us day and night, keeping us safe so we can grow in the best environment.

4. A Life That Brings Blessings to the World (Isaiah 27:6, 12-13; Genesis 12:2-3)

<u>Isaiah 27:6</u> In the future, Jacob will take root, Israel will bud and blossom, and their fruit will fill the world.

<u>Isaiah 27:12-13</u> In that day the LORD will thresh from the flowing Euphrates to the Wadi of Egypt, and you, Israel, will be gathered up one by one.

13 And in that day a great trumpet will sound. Those who were perishing in Assyria and those who were exiled in Egypt will come and worship the LORD on the holy mountain in Jerusalem.

Genesis 12:2-3

"I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.

3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

God will bless us so that we can be a blessing to all people!

II. Removing Sin and Returning to God (Isaiah 27:11, 7-11)

saiah 27:11 When its twigs are dry, they are broken off and women come and make fires with them. For this is a people without understanding; so their Maker has no compassion on them, and their Creator shows them no favor.

The Key Reason for Missing God's Blessings:

Lack of Understanding (v.11b)

People refuse to acknowledge the one true, greatest, most powerful, and most loving God.

They betray God and rely on idols instead. They are proud and think they know everything. They reject God's constant calls of love and refuse His efforts to bring them back.

To Turn Hard Times into Blessings, Sin Must Be Removed!

God's way of dealing with $\sin (v.7-11)$:

<u>Isaiah 27:7-11</u> Has the LORD struck her as he struck down those who struck her? Has she been killed as those were killed who killed her?

- **8** By warfare and exile you contend with her—with his fierce blast he drives her out, as on a day the east wind blows.
- 9By this, then, will Jacob's guilt be atoned for, and this will be the full fruit of the removal of his sin: When he makes all the altar stones to be like limestone crushed to pieces, no Asherah poles[™] or incense altars will be left standing.
- **10** The fortified city stands desolate, an abandoned settlement, forsaken like the wilderness; there the calves graze, there they lie down; they strip its branches bare.
- 11 When its twigs are dry, they are broken off and women come and make fires with them. For this is a people without understanding; so their Maker has no compassion on them, and their Creator shows them no favor.

III. Make Peace with God and Return to Him_ (Isaiah 27:5, 9, 7-8, 4)

<u>Isaiah 27:5</u> Or else let them come to me for refuge; let them make peace with me, yes, let them make peace with me."

<u>Isaiah 27:9</u> By this, then, will Jacob's guilt be atoned for, and this will be the full fruit of the removal of his sin: When he makes all the altar stones to be like limestone crushed to pieces, no Asherah poles or incense altars will be left standing.

Repent and Turn Back to God. Let go of pride. Get rid of idols.

Stop relying on anything other than God!

Three Key Points:

God Alone. Unshakable Faith. Greatest Love.

What Is an Idol?

- Anything in your heart that is more important than God.
- Anything you depend on instead of God.
- Anything you love more than God, to the point that you disobey Him for it.

Common Idols:

• Yourself (pride, selfishness)

- Money (wealth, possessions)
- Future Plans (career, success)
- **Power** (status, influence)
- Sinful Pleasures (desires, bad habits)
- Family & Relationships (children, boyfriend/girlfriend)

God Loves You So Much!

He eagerly wants to turn your hard times into blessings so that you can bless others!

What Should You Do?

- Repent completely—turn away from sin and never go back!
- **Get rid of idols**—let nothing take God's place in your heart.
- <u>Call on Jesus constantly—ask Him to watch</u> over you and help you!
- Call on His name, and you will be saved!

How Can You Grow in Faith?

- **Join a church gathering**—encourage each other, show love, and do good.
- Read and meditate on God's Word day and night.
- Talk about God's Word with others.

The Key to True Repentance and Faith in Jesus: Remove all idols. Trust in Jesus alone. Believe in Him completely. Love Him above all else! Seponsive Hymn
