Isaiah 36:18

“Do not let Hezekiah mislead you when he says, ‘The LORD will **deliver** us.’ Have the gods of **any** nations ever **delivered** their lands **from** the hand of the king of Assyria?”

Isaiah 37:1, 20

1 When King Hezekiah heard this, he tore his clothes and put on **sackcloth** and went into the **temple** of the Lord.

20 Now, Lord our God, **deliver** us from his hand, so that **all the kingdoms of the earth** may **know** that **you, Lord, are the only God.**”

Do I have any trash, clutter, lies, or fake messages in my heart? How do I discern them?

I. Recognizing Lies

1. False Analysis (Isaiah 36:8, 18; 37:11)

Isaiah 36:8, 18 “Come now, make a bargain with my master, the king of Assyria: I will give you two thousand horses—if you can put riders on them!

18 “Do not let Hezekiah mislead you when he says, ‘The LORD will deliver us.’ Have the gods of any nations ever delivered their lands from the hand of the king of Assyria?”

37:11 Surely you have heard what the kings of Assyria have done to all the countries, destroying them completely. And will you be delivered?”

The enemy provides a rational analysis of objective circumstances and history, making us focus on the environment and the "impossible."

2. False Hope (Isaiah 36:17)

Isaiah 36:17 until I come and take you to a land like your own—a land of grain and new wine, a land of bread and vineyards.

The enemy gives false hope, promising peace and abundance if we surrender and worship idols.

3. Half-truths (Isaiah 36:6-7)

Isaiah 36:6-7 Look, I know you are depending on Egypt, that splintered reed of a staff, which pierces the hand of anyone who leans on it! Such is Pharaoh king of Egypt to all who depend on him.

7 But if you say to me, “We are depending on the LORD our God”—isn’t he the one whose high places and altars Hezekiah removed, saying to Judah and Jerusalem, “You must worship before this altar”?”

It is true that relying on Egypt is useless, but the enemy mixes this truth with the lie that relying on God is also useless. The enemy uses partial facts to create confusion.

4. False Prophecy (Isaiah 36:10)

Isaiah 36:10 Furthermore, have I come to attack and destroy this land without the LORD? The LORD himself told me to march against this country and destroy it.”

The Assyrians claim that their invasion is God’s will, which is a lie. Satan disguises himself as an angel of light, presenting his intentions as if they were God’s will.

5. Prayer is Useless (Isaiah 36:7)

Isaiah 36:7 But if you say to me, “We are depending on the LORD our God”—isn’t he the one whose high places and altars Hezekiah removed, saying to Judah and Jerusalem, “You must worship before this altar”?”

The enemy suggests that prayer is ineffective. The lie is that prayer, worship, and trusting God are useless.

6. Sowing Discord (Isaiah 36:14)

Isaiah 36:14 This is what the king says: Do not let Hezekiah deceive you. He cannot deliver you!

The enemy attacks the people's trust in King Hezekiah, calling him a deceiver. The enemy attacks our relationship with Jesus, the church, and spiritual leaders.

II. Prayer to Cleanse Lies

1. Be Silent and Wait (Isaiah 36:21)

Isaiah 36:21 But the people remained silent and said nothing in reply, because the king had commanded, “Do not answer him.”

The people remained silent, not saying a word, not responding to the lies!

"Speak to God first, then speak to others."

"Refuse to engage in conversation with the wrong people!" This includes enemies, those with little faith, unbelievers, and negative or critical people.

2. Repentant Prayer (Isaiah 36:22; 37:1-2; 2 Kings 18:14)

Isaiah 36:22; 37:1-2 Then Eliakim son of Hilkiyah the palace administrator, Shebna the secretary and Joah son of Asaph the recorder went to Hezekiah, with their clothes torn, and told him what the field commander had said.

37:1-2 When King Hezekiah heard this, he tore his clothes and put on sackcloth and went into the temple of the Lord.

2 He sent Eliakim the palace administrator, Shebna the secretary, and the leading priests, all wearing sackcloth, to the prophet Isaiah son of Amoz.

2 Kings 18:14 So Hezekiah king of Judah sent this message to the king of Assyria at Lachish: "I have done wrong. Withdraw from me, and I will pay whatever you demand of me." The king of Assyria exacted from Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents^{of} silver and thirty talents^{of} of gold.

"King Hezekiah tore his clothes, put on sackcloth, and in sorrow and repentance, went into the temple to pray!

He repented before God for using money to bribe the king of Assyria in the past and decided to trust God alone!

The first step is to **confess and repent to God**. When relationships are tense, start by repenting to God, and things will change!"

3. Seek Spiritual Guidance (Isaiah 37:2, 5-7; James 5:16)

Isaiah 37:2 He sent Eliakim the palace administrator, Shebna the secretary, and the leading priests, all wearing sackcloth, to the prophet Isaiah son of Amoz.

5-7 When King Hezekiah's officials came to Isaiah, **6** Isaiah said to them, "Tell your master, 'This is what the LORD says: Do not be afraid of what you have heard—those words with which the underlings of the king of Assyria have blasphemed me.

7 Listen! When he hears a certain report, I will make him want to return to his own country, and there I will have him cut down with the sword.'"

James 5:16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

"King Hezekiah urgently asked Isaiah to pray and seek God's will!

We should actively join the church, take up the authority God has given the church to pray, and pray for each other!"

4. Focus on Truly Knowing God (Isaiah 37:20; Philippians 1:12, 20)

Isaiah 37:20 Now, LORD our God, deliver us from his hand, so that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you, LORD, are the only God.^{is}"

Philippians 1:12, 20 Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually served to advance the gospel.

20 I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

"The focus of prayer is not just to solve the problems in front of us, because we can't solve everything.

The focus is 'so that all nations may know that You alone are the Lord,' helping people know and trust in God!

A new spiritual level: Everything I go through should **bring glory to God and the gospel to others!**

In waiting, I experience God's provision; in sickness, I experience God's comfort and go comfort others!

What are the lies and garbage in my heart? How can I stay alert and pray for myself and others?"
