Sermon: Jesus' Love Is Closer Than I Thought

When I and those around me face problems and feel discouraged, how can we find comfort? Where can we find a way out?

I. Jesus Is Ready to Hold Me!

1. Victory in Life's Battles (v.1-2; 2 Cor. 2:14; John 19:30

<u>Isaiah 40:1-2</u> Your God says, "Comfort, comfort my people."

- 2 Speak kindly to Jerusalem and tell her that her hard times are over, her sins are forgiven, and she has received enough punishment from the Lord for all her sins
- **2 Cor. 2:1** But thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of him everywhere.

John 19:30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Before this passage, God's people were attacked by enemies and faced sickness, but the Lord tells them their battle is over—they have won!

God gives us victory through Christ! Jesus shouted on the cross, "It is finished!"

No matter what troubles we face, Jesus leads the way, Jesus has won, and through Him, we will also win!

2. Forgiveness of Sins (v.2; Isaiah 53:5-6)

<u>Isaiah 40:2</u> Speak **kindly** to Jerusalem and tell her that **her hard times are over,** her **sins are forgiven**, and she has received enough punishment from the Lord for all her sins

<u>Isaiah 53:5-6</u> But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Arguments at home and work, sadness and struggles—all come from selfishness, greed, and desires in people's hearts.

Jesus forgives our sins and took our punishment. God placed all our sins on Him.

Jesus suffered, was wounded, and punished so that we could be healed and have peace. He gives us a new heart—holy, loving, and full of joy!

3. Jesus' Loving Arms (v.10-11)

<u>Isaiah 40:10-11</u> See, the Sovereign LORD comes with power, and he rules with a mighty arm. See, his reward is with him, and his recompense accompanies him.

11 He will take care of His sheep like a shepherd. He will hold the little lambs in His arms, carry them close to His heart, and gently lead the mother sheep.

With His strong arms, the Lord fights for us, taking away sin's darkness and Satan's plans!

With His loving arms, He gathers the lambs, holds them close, and gently leads those who care for others.

We receive love from Him and share His love with others!

II. The Key to Feeling Jesus' Love: Meeting Him!

1. Seeing His Glory (v.5)

<u>Isaiah 40:5</u> Then **the glory** of the Lord **will be seen by everyone together**. The Lord himself has spoken."

Everyone will see God's glory. When we see Him, we will understand what He has done for us—we will know that He carries our burdens, forgives our sins, and wins our battles!

2. Listening to His Word (v.8)

<u>Isaiah 40:8</u> The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever."

Everything on earth is temporary, like flowers and grass, but the Word of the Lord lasts forever. God reveals Himself to people through His truth. Jesus, the Word made flesh, shows us God's power and love!

III. How Can We Meet the Lord? (v.3-4)

<u>Isaiah 40:3-4</u> A voice is calling: "Prepare the way for the Lord in the desert; make a straight road for our God in the dry land.

4 Every **valley** will be raised up, every **mountain and hill** will be made low; the rough ground will become smooth, and **the uneven places** will become flat.

To see God's glory, we must prepare the way for the Lord and build a "spiritual highway"—so we can quickly come to Him, see Him, hear Him, and receive His comfort and love!

1. Removing Pride (v.3-4, 6-8)

<u>Isaiah 40:3-4</u> A voice is calling: "Prepare the way for the Lord in the desert; make a straight road for our God in the dry land.

4 Every **valley** will be raised up, every **mountain and hill** will be made low; the rough ground will become smooth, and **the uneven places** will become flat.

- **6** A voice says, "Cry out." And I said, "What shall I cry?" "All people are like grass, and all their faithfulness is like the flowers of the field.
- 7 The grass withers and the flowers fall, because the breath of the Lord blows on them. Surely the people are grass.
- **8** The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever."

The mountains and hills must be made low—pride in our hearts must be removed!

Human beauty and success are like grass and flowers—they do not last!

We must humble ourselves before God, recognize that we are small, and see that He is great! Say: "I can't, but God can!"

2. Removing Low Self-Worth (v.4)

<u>Isaiah 40:4</u> Every valley will be raised up, every mountain and hill will be made low; the rough ground will become smooth, and the uneven places will become flat.

The valleys must be filled—low self-worth and weakness must be removed! The world tells us lies, saying, "I am not good enough." But Jesus sees us as valuable and loved! Jesus loves us, we are His children, and He fights for us and holds us close!

3. Removing Dishonesty (v.4; Psalm 18:26)

<u>Isaiah 40:4</u> Every valley will be raised up, every mountain and hill will be made low; the rough ground will become smooth, and the uneven places will become flat.

<u>Psalm 18:26</u> to the pure you show yourself pure, but to the devious you show yourself shrewd.

The rough places must be made smooth—dishonesty and deception must be removed! Come to God with honesty, no more twisting the truth, but fully obeying Him! Whatever God says, I will believe and follow—then I will experience His love, peace, and joy!
