☞Sermon: God's Four Comforts (Part 3)

The Third Comfort: Being Loved by God

God Himself holds us close, guides us, and gives us rewards.

Q: How can we enjoy this comfort from God?

A: We need to have the right view of three things:
Eternity – Understand that this life is not everything.
God – Know that God is powerful, loving, and always with us.

Ourselves – See ourselves the way God sees us—with love and purpose.

I. The Right View of Eternity (Isaiah 40:10a; Romans 8:17)

Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

One day, God will judge the whole world.

That's why what matters most is **eternity**, not just what we have right now.

(Isaiah 40:10a) and **(Romans 8:1)** remind us:

Romans 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,

What do people care about most?
What should God's people care about?

There is one important truth about eternity: **God's timing is perfect**. Even if we don't see it right away, we need to trust Him.

We must wait with **faith and patience** for God's perfect timing—
Just like **Joseph, Moses, and David** did.

* **The right view of eternity:**

Eternity is more important than this life, and we believe in **God's timing**.

II. The Right View of God (Isaiah 40:11; 2 Chronicles 32:22)

2 Chronicles 32:22 So the Lord saved Hezekiah and the people of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib king of Assyria and from the hand of all others. He took care of them on every side.

What kind of God do you believe in? Your answer affects whether you can truly feel His best comfort right now.

Is your view of God based on **what He says about Himself** in the Bible, or just based on **your own ideas**?

God's comfort includes two powerful truths:

- **He is in control** of everything.
- **He deeply loves His people**.

When we feel afraid, worried, or even hopeless, God uses His strong arm to **defeat evil** and His loving arms to **hold and protect us**.

The Bible says He **guides us**, which means He leads us into a place of **peace (2 Chronicles 32:22)**.

He **holds us close to His heart** and **gives peace to His whole flock**.

* **The right view of God:**

God is the highest ruler over all things, and He loves His people very, very much!

III. The Right View of Yourself (Isaiah 40:11; Psalm 8)

Psalm 8:1-9 For the director of music. According to gittith. A psalm of David.

1 Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

You have set your glory in the heavens.

2 Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.

3 When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers,

the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,

4 what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?

5 You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them[f] with glory and honor.

6 You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their[g] feet:

7 all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild,

8 the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.

9 Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

In God's eyes, **we are His treasure**—we are priceless!

The world may tell us that we are not important, or when we compare ourselves to the vast sky and earth, we might feel small and worthless.

But the Bible says something very different.

God sees us as His precious ones (Isaiah 40:11).

This special worth doesn't come from what the world says, or even from how we feel about ourselves. It comes from **God's truth**—His Word shows us who we really are.

* **The right view of yourself:**

We are God's treasure—**priceless in His eyes!**

Jesus, who became human, strongly showed us the **right view of eternity**:

He taught that the greatest blessing from God is **eternal life, heaven, and God's kingdom**. Because of this, it's worth giving up everything in this life to gain eternal life.

Jesus also clearly showed us the **right view of God**:

He died on the cross to save us and rose again from the dead. Through this, He showed that **God is all-powerful and full of love**.

Jesus also revealed the **right view of ourselves**:

By giving His life for us, He declared to the whole universe that **we are God's treasure**, His deeply loved people.

If we choose to believe what Jesus shows us about eternity, God, and ourselves, **we can start experiencing God's comfort right now!**
