Sermon: When My Sky Falls Apart... - Pastor Hsu

Suddenly, my body breaks down. I lose my job. A loved one passes away. It feels like the sky is falling. Where can I find peace?

Psalm 90:8 Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts.
Psalm 16:4 Those who run after other gods will suffer more and more. I will not pour out libations of blood to such gods or take up their names on my lips.

Matthew 11:29–30 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

I. Trusting in idols leads to emptiness (Psalm 96:5,10; Psalm 16:4; Matthew 11:29–30)

When the Lord is King, the world stands firm and unshaken.

When God reigns, the earth is steady and provides all we need. Our hearts become strong and peaceful.

Trusting the one true God brings real peace. But trusting idols (false gods) leads to emptiness and sorrow.

Emptiness means: no real value, no lasting help.

Many people make other things their "king":

- Judas made money his king.
- The people of Babel made success their king.
- Samson made **feelings and relationships** his king.
- Eli made his **children** his king.
- King Saul cared too much about his image.
- Solomon made himself king over God.

When we feel stressed or sad, it's like a wake-up alarm.

Ask yourself: "Is my burden light? Whose burden am I carrying?" (Matthew 11:30)

<u>Psalm 16:8</u> "I keep my eyes always on the Lord. With Him at my right hand, I will not be shaken."

<u>62:6</u> "He alone is my rock and my salvation; He is my strong tower—I will not be shaken."

125:1 "Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but stands forever."

Psalm 115:1 Not to us, LORD, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness.

Romans 11:36 "Everything comes from God, everything depends on Him, and everything exists to bring Him glory."

II. When God is King, we become unshakable

When God is in front of me, When He is my rock—I will not be shaken! (Psalm 16:8; 62:6; 125:1)

1. Give glory to God (Psalm 96:7–8; Romans 11:36; Psalm 115:1)

When you feel tired and burdened, think: "Am I chasing my own glory?"

Do I want attention? Do I want people to notice or praise me?

How many likes or followers do I have? Why are others more successful than me?

Trying to get our own glory brings heavy pressure— It can even lead to dark and sinful choices.

(John 3:29–30; 1 Corinthians 4:3–4; Acts 3:12; Matthew 11:29–30)

We should shift our focus: "Does God get the glory?"

- John the Baptist said: "Jesus must become greater; I must become less."
- Paul said: "I don't care what people think—only God's judgment matters."
- Peter and John said: "It's not our power or goodness." That brings freedom and joy!

John 3:29–30 The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete.

30He must become greater; I must become less." [a]

- <u>1 Corinthians 4:3–4</u> I care very little if I am judged by you or by any human court; indeed, I do not even judge myself.
- 4 My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me.

Acts 3:12 When Peter saw this, he said to them: "Fellow Israelites, why does this surprise you? Why do you stare at us as if by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk?

Matthew 11:29–30 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

2. Give strength to God (Psalm 96:7)

Believe that all strength comes from God:

- David faced Goliath.
- Elisha faced a mighty army.
- Paul faced danger and pain.

But they trusted God. "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength."

(1 Samuel 17:45; 2 Kings 6:16–17; 2 Corinthians 1:8–9; Philippians 4:13)

1 Samuel 17:45 David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.

- 2 Kings 6:16–17 "Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them."
- 17 And Elisha prayed, "Open his eyes, Lord, so that he may see." Then the Lord opened the servant's eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.
- <u>2 Corinthians 1:8–9</u> We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about the troubles we experienced in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself.
- 9 Indeed, we felt we had received the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all this through him who gives me strength.

3. Offer your best to God (Psalm 96:8-9; 2 Timothy 2:21)

2 Timothy 2:21 Those who cleanse themselves from the latter will be instruments for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

Let God be King in your life—bring Him gifts. Give Him your offering, your prayers, your time, your energy, and your love.

Serve Him in holy beauty:

- First: **Dress** modestly and respectfully.
- Second: Keep a holy heart that respects God.
- Third: See God's holiness and let it shape you. Be a **clean and ready vessel** for His use!
