☞ **Sermon: Silent Questions Before Heaven**

I. When I Have No Words, I Question Heaven

1. I will speak – Psalm 10:1; Job 7:11

Psalm 10:1 Why, Lord, do you stand far off? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble?

Job 7:11 Therefore I will not keep silent; I will speak out in the anguish of my spirit, I will complain in the bitterness of my soul.

I will speak out! I will not suppress, endure, or fear.

“Why me? Why must I go through such pain and hardship?” Speak it out — God is willing to listen to your heart.

2. I will think – Psalm 143:5; 77:12–14; 78:35

Psalm 143:5 I remember the days of long ago; I meditate on all your works and consider what your hands have done.

Psalm 77:12–14 I will consider all your works and meditate on all your mighty deeds.

Your ways, God, are holy. What god is as great as our God?

You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples.

Psalm 78:35 They remembered that God was their Rock, that God Most High was their Redeemer.

I will reflect and remember — from the past until now, from the smallest to the greatest things — how good God has been, how many times He has rescued me just in time. This is a battle of the mind!

3. I will resist – Job 2:10; Matthew 4:4, 7, 10

Job 2:10 He replied, “You are talking like a foolish woman. Shall we accept good from God, and not trouble?” In all this, Job did not sin in what he said.

Matthew 4:4 Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.’”

Matthew 4:7 Jesus answered him, “It is also written: ‘Do not put the Lord your God to the test.’”

Matthew 4:10 Jesus said to him, “Away from me, Satan! For it is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.’”

Satan keeps sending floods of negative thoughts and images to paralyze and crush you. Do not accept or agree — reject and end them with God’s truth. Stand firm and escape quickly — this is your spiritual “quick exit.”

4. I will pray – James 5:13; Psalm 34:6

James 5:13 Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise.

Psalm 34:6 This poor man called, and the Lord heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles.

This is your right — your everlasting right.

Pray with all your heart, cling to His promises, and cry out without reservation.

He surely hears you — He’s been listening all along. Don’t stop calling on Him!

5. I will wait – Isaiah 40:31; 33:2; Psalm 27:14; Lamentations 3:26

Isaiah 40:31 But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Isaiah 33:2 Lord, be gracious to us; we long for you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation in time of distress.

Psalm 27:14 Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart
and wait for the Lord.

Lamentations 3:26 It is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord.

Waiting is a lesson we must learn — it’s a process of transformation, a test of faith, a ladder toward victory.

Waiting helps you meet the Lord face to face, preparing you for His greatest glory and joy.

6. I will win – 2 Corinthians 2:14; 12:9

2 Corinthians 2:14 But thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ’s triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere.

2 Corinthians 12:9 But He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.

When I am weak, then I am strong.
When I lack, I am made rich.
When I fear, I become bold — for Christ’s power rests upon me. I will rise up and soar on wings like eagles!

II. Heaven Is Here

1. The Lord knows all – **Hebrews 4:15**

Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

Our greatest comfort and hope: Jesus truly knows our pain. He has suffered, tasted, and experienced it Himself. Jesus fully understands your sorrow.

2. The Lord bears with us – **Psalms 68:19**

Psalms 68:19 Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens.

We are never alone in carrying our burdens or struggles. Jesus walks step by step with us and carries us each day. You are never alone on this thorny road — He bears you in His arms.

3. The Lord suffers with us – **Isaiah 63:9**

Isaiah 63:9 In all their distress he too was distressed, and the angel of his presence saved them. In his love and mercy he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.

Our good Shepherd shares in our suffering.
When you hurt, He hurts; when you cry, He cries. He has truly borne our griefs and carried our sorrows — this is real!

4. The Lord can do all things – **2 Corinthians 12:9; Matthew 19:26**

2 Corinthians 12:9 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.

Matthew 19:26 Jesus looked at them and said, “With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”

What mountain can He not move? What storm can He not calm? What battle can He not win? What sickness can He not heal? What power can He not break? What soul can He not save? With Him, all things are possible — and in faith, you can believe all things!

5. The Lord truly loves – **Isaiah 63:9; 1 John 4:9–10, 19; Galatians 2:20**

Isaiah 63:9 In all their distress he too was distressed, and the angel of his presence saved them. In his love and mercy he redeemed them; he lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.

1 John 4:9 This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.

1 John 4:10 This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

1 John 4:19 We love because he first loved us.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me.

“God must hate me — that’s why I’m suffering like this.” That is a terrible lie! Jesus loves you so deeply He gave His life for you — unconditionally, undeservedly. He loves you — simply because He is love.
