🎵Sermon:

"A Glimpse into the Father's Notebook"

Revelation 17:8; 13:8; 20:15 The beast, which you saw, once was, now is not, and yet will come up out of the Abyss and go to its destruction. The inhabitants of the earth whose names have not been written in the book of life from the creation of the world will be astonished when they see the beast, because it once was, now is not, and yet will come.

13:8 All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world.

20:15 Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

I. The Book of Life:

Before the judgment seat there is the Book of Life, which records the names of those who trust in the Lord, are saved, and receive eternal life.

1. Those whose names are removed from the Book of Life will face punishment — **(Revelation 17:8; 13:8; 20:15)**

- 1) **Deceived:** Led astray and deceived, filled with amazement, fear, and confusion.
- 2) **Idolatry:** Worshiping the devil and idols, falling into darkness, lies, and corruption.
- 3) **Cast into the lake of fire:** Thrown into the lake of fire to suffer eternal punishment.

Daniel 12:1 “At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered.

Revelation 21:27 Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

2. Those whose names remain in the Book of Life will receive salvation — **(Daniel 12:1; Revelation 21:27)**

In times of great tribulation, challenges, and suffering, they will receive personal and complete salvation.

They will enter the New Jerusalem, enjoy eternal life, and reign with the Lord forever.

Exodus 32:32–33 But now, please forgive their sin—but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written.”

33 The LORD replied to Moses, “Whoever has sinned against me I will blot out of my book.

Psalms 69:28 May they be blotted out of the book of life and not be listed with the righteous.

Revelation 3:5 The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels.

3. The righteous are recorded; the wicked are blotted out — **(Exodus 32:32–33; Psalms 69:28; Revelation 3:5)**

The Book of Life records Moses; the names of the righteous are written in the Book of Life, while the names of the wicked are blotted out.

Those who overcome by holding fast to their faith in tribulation will be clothed in white. God will never blot out their names from the Book of Life, but will acknowledge their names—this is great honor and glory.

Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books.

Malachi 3:16 Then those who feared the LORD talked with each other, and the LORD listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the LORD and honored his name.

2 Corinthians 5:14 For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

2 Timothy 4:8 Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

II. The Book of Remembrance: **(Revelation 20:12)**

What is recorded in the Book of Remembrance before the judgment seat?

1. The words and deeds of those who fear the Lord — **(Malachi 3:16; 2 Corinthians 5:14; 2 Timothy 4:8)**

God records the words of those who fear Him and records our love for the Lord and our thoughts toward Him.

To remember/think upon means to plan and to purpose; as we meditate on the Lord's love, He grants the crown of righteousness.

Matthew 26:10 Aware of this, Jesus said to them, "Why are you bothering this woman? She has done a beautiful thing to me.

Acts 13:2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

Revelation 14:13 Then I heard a voice from heaven say, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them."

Matthew 10:42 And if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones who is my disciple, truly I tell you, that person will certainly not lose their reward."

1) Loving God (Matthew 26:10; Acts 13:2; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Revelation 14:13; Matthew 10:42)

Jesus records what we do for Him—pouring out perfume, pioneering the gospel, serving God wholeheartedly—and He will reward us.

Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Acts 9:36 In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (in Greek her name is Dorcas); she was always doing good and helping the poor.

1 Timothy 6:18 Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share.

Revelation 14:13 Then I heard a voice from heaven say, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them."

Matthew 25:32 All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

2) Loving others (Matthew 5:16; Acts 9:36; 1 Timothy 6:18; Matthew 25:32)

The Lord records every act of love toward others—our good deeds, acts of kindness, generosity, and sharing.

To do good, to be rich in good deeds, to be generous and willing to share—these are set apart and blessed by the Lord.

Psalms 56:8 Record my misery; list my tears on your scroll[a]— are they not in your record?

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

2. Suffering and tears (Psalms 56:8; Romans 8:32)

God records our wanderings, our sufferings, and our tears. God knows; God treasures them. Every suffering we endure, Jesus has borne, and the Heavenly Father has experienced.

Psalms 139:16 Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

Acts 5:38 Therefore, in the present case I advise you: Leave these men alone! Let them go! For if their purpose or activity is of human origin, it will fail.

3. Good and beautiful plans (Psalms 139:16; Acts 5:38)

God has prepared beautiful plans and abundant gifts for us to experience and enjoy. What is from God will surely come to pass; therefore, we must seek God.

What God values, I value.
What God hates, I reject.
What God records, I record.

We record the words of those who fear God, their offerings, their love for the Lord and for others, becoming a "cloud of witnesses"—a database of testimonies that surrounds us and ignites our faith.

The Father's Notebook

In the Book of Life, the Lord records names;
In the Book of Remembrance, the Lord records deeds.
