**18** My sorrow is beyond healing; my heart is faint within me.

**19** Listen! The cry of my people comes from a distant land:

“Is the LORD not in Zion? Is her King no longer there?”

The LORD says: “Why have they provoked Me to anger with their carved images, with their worthless foreign idols?”

**9:1** Oh, that my head were a spring of water and my eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of my people.

☞ **Sermon: A Pillar in the Midst of the Current**

We are living in an age of syncretism and compromise in faith—an age also marked by God’s judgment.

What does it matter if faith is compromised? What does it matter if we believe everything—or believe in nothing? What does it matter if we do not believe in God?

How, then, should we respond and overcome, becoming pillars in the midst of our generation?

**I. Continually Seek God’s Illumination in Humility**

We must all confront the challenges, assaults, and contamination of secularized belief.

“Erroneous faith” and “compromise ideology” proclaim: God is not exclusive; Scripture is not authoritative.

Such thinking dulls the heart to God’s rebuke, warning, exhortation, and calling.

It strips people of self-examination, fills them with doubt, and leaves them complaining—drifting farther and farther from God.

The way out: The prophet Jeremiah chose continual dialogue with God, receiving His illumination, revelation, and guidance.

Never neglect this posture of self-examination—this trembling, humble prostration and earnest cry before God.

**Jeremiah 11:21** Therefore this is what the Lord says about the people of Anathoth who are threatening to kill you, saying, “Do not prophesy in the name of the Lord or you will die by our hands”—

**Jeremiah 8:20–22** “The harvest is past, the summer has ended, and we are not saved.”

**21** Since my people are crushed, I am crushed; I mourn, and horror grips me.

**22** Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no physician there? Why then is there no healing for the wound of my people?

**II. Holding Both Lovingkindness and Justice (Jeremiah 11:21; 8:21–22; 9:1)s**

To be a pillar and a watchman in our time, we must embody both lovingkindness and justice—neither can be absent.

Without justice, one becomes like the Sadducees—compromising, secularized, and detestable to God.

Without lovingkindness, one becomes like the Pharisees—self-righteous, hypocritical, harshly critical of the world, provoking indignation from both God and people.

**2 Timothy 1:7** For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

**Romans 8:4** in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

**Galatians 6:8** Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

**III. Meditating on God’s Word**

How can we possess a heart like Jeremiah’s or Moses’—a heart both just and compassionate?

Only Jesus Christ is the source of love and the source of righteousness.

To believe in Jesus is to receive a spirit of power, love, and self-discipline (**Timothy 1:7**).

To walk in obedience to the Holy Spirit is to bear the fruit of the Spirit (**Romans 8:4; Galatians 6:8**).

Meditating on God’s Word is the most crucial and secure way to receive His lovingkindness and justice.

Meditate sincerely and earnestly—asking what, why, how, who, when...

**1 Thessalonians 2:13** And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as

a human word, but as it actually is, the word of God, which is indeed at work in you who believe.

Then the Word of God—His truth—will be at work within you (**1 Thessalonians 2:13**), energizing and operating in your life. You will grow sensitive to the Spirit’s prompting and leading. The truth will enable you to discern right from wrong. Naturally and decisively, you will distance yourself from syncretistic faith, false belief, compromise, and secularized religion. You will walk the path of holiness — unstained by the mire—standing as a pillar in your generation.

**Jeremiah 46:11** “Go up to Gilead and get balm, Virgin Daughter Egypt. But you try many medicines in vain; there is no healing for you.

Those who persist in compromise and syncretism will never obtain true healing (**Jeremiah 46:11**).

No matter how corrupt, unclean, compromising, tempting, or chaotic the age may be, if we humbly seek God and diligently meditate on His Word, our lives will resemble the lotus—rising from the mud yet remaining unstained.

Be faithful to God. Discern truth from falsehood. Hold both justice and lovingkindness.

Revere God sincerely. Delight in Him. Live for Him. Love your neighbor as yourself. Willingly deny yourself and take up your cross. Then you will receive a hundredfold blessing in this life and eternal life in the age to come. Take joy in glorifying God, and stand as a pillar in your generation forever.
