II. The Path to Glory

John 8:54 Jesus replied, “If I glorify myself, my glory means nothing. My Father, whom you claim as your God, is the one who glorifies me.

5:44 How can you believe since you accept glory from one another but do not seek the glory that comes from the only God[a]?

12:42–43 Yet at the same time many even among the leaders believed in him. But because of the Pharisees they would not openly acknowledge their faith for fear they would be put out of the synagogue; **43** for they loved human praise more than praise from God.

Matthew 23:5–7, 13 “Everything they do is done for people to see: They make their phylacteries[a] wide and the tassels on their garments long;

6 they love the place of honor at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues;

7 they love to be greeted with respect in the marketplaces and to be called ‘Rabbi’ by others.

13 “Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven in people’s faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to.

Romans 8:4 in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Galatians 6:8 Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

I. We Need Honor

1. Honor in Tears (John 12:23–24; 17:1)

Jesus viewed the cross as the very moment when the Son of Man would be glorified.

His arrest, trial, and crucifixion were filled with glory.

Even in our tears, we can still possess great honor and living hope.

John 13:3–4 Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God;

4 so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist.

2. Honor Enables Us to Love (John 13:3–4)

Jesus received glory from the Father so that He might glorify the Father.

When we carry the glory God has given us — understanding His will daily, receiving strength to obey His Word, and living out the likeness of Jesus — we will surely glorify God.

1. Stop Seeking Human Glory (John 8:54; 5:44; 12:42–43; Matthew 23:5–7, 13)

The greatest enemy of “heavenly glory” is “earthly glory.”

When people rush to glorify themselves, such glory is empty and pale.

When people seek glory from one another, they cannot truly believe in Jesus or receive heavenly glory.

When someone loves the glory of man more than the glory of God, they will not dare to confess they are Christians and will live in fear. If we deny the Lord on earth, He will not acknowledge us in heaven.

The Pharisees gained earthly glory but lost heavenly glory.

When we behold the “eternal weight of glory,” all earthly glory is insignificant.

John 12:23–24 Jesus replied, “The hour has come for the Son of Man to **be glorified**.

24 Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat

falls into the earth and **dies**, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.”

21:19 Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, “Follow me!”

John 17:1, 4 After Jesus said this, He looked toward heaven and prayed: “Father, the hour has come.

Glorify Your Son, that Your Son may glorify You.”

4 I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do.

14:13 And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

2. **Deny Yourself and Follow to the End** (**John 12:23–24; 21:19; 17:1, 4; 14:13**)

The path of glory for the Son of Man was this: a grain of wheat falling into the ground and dying — complete self-denial and obedience to God.

Peter’s path to glorify God was to follow Jesus, even unto death.

To glorify the Lord is to accomplish what God has entrusted to us.

To do God’s work concretely is to pray—connecting with the Lord, understanding His heart, and responding precisely.

John 17:22 I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—

Mark 10:16 And he took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them.

Matthew 8:3 Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. “I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!” Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.

3. **Actively Love Others** (**John 17:22; Mark 10:16; Matthew 8:3**)

Glory enables us to be one, to promote unity, to genuinely love others, and to actively honor others.

Because Jesus possesses the highest glory, He was able to give the greatest love and honor to those around Him.

He embraced children and touched the leper — this is also our calling.
