🔗 **Scripture Reading: Matthew 21:8–9, 12–15, 18–19, 22**

8 A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

9 The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, “Hosanna to the Son of David!” “Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” “Hosanna in the highest heaven!”

12 Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves.

13 “It is written,” he said to them, “‘My house will be called a house of prayer,’ but you are making it ‘a den of robbers.’”

🔗 **Sermon: Dual Voices ~ Pastor Dong**

I. Introduction

What is the difference between the “Hosanna” shouted before and after the cleansing of the temple?

II. Main Points

1. Different Ways

(1) The people sought revolution — to rebuild an earthly kingdom.

The motive of our faith determines the direction of our service and reveals the true condition of our hearts.

(2) Jesus chose to lay down His life — to establish a heavenly kingdom.

The obedient will of the Lord Jesus determined His path to the cross and revealed the orientation of His heart.

2. Incompatibility

(1) The priests defiled the temple — turning a holy place for communion with God into a den of trade with people.

(2) Jesus cleansed the temple — transforming the noise of collusion with sin into the sound of prayer that connects with God.

3. No Convergence

(1) The tree had only leaves — what should have been there was absent; the fruit of the Spirit was lacking, replaced by empty glory.

(2) Jesus found no fruit — there was no good testimony in life, only boastful words and actions.

III. Conclusion

The simple cries of children surpass the shouts of the crowd.

The authoritative rebuke of Jesus overpowers the noise of the merchants.

The steadfast prayers of believers are stronger than the roaring of Satan.
