What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

**Sermon: Resurrection —
If God Helps Us, Who Can Stand Against Us?**

Romans 8:13-26, 28, 32, 35-39 For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

14 For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship.[a] And by him we cry, “Abba,[b] Father.”

16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God’s children.

17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

18 I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

19 For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed.

20 For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope

21 that[c] the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God.

22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

23 Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies.

24 For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have?

25 But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently.

26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who[a] have been called according to his purpose.

32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

33 Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies.

35-39 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?

36 As it is written: “For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered.”[a]

37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons,[b] neither the present nor the future, nor any powers,

39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 10:9-13 If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

11 As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.”[a]

12 For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him,

13 for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

If God is for us, who can hinder us from receiving resurrection and eternal life?

What blessings does the resurrection of Jesus bring to those who believe in Him?

God helps us to receive seven blessings that no one can resist:

1. **The grace of resurrection** (v.13, 18–25)
2. **The identity as children of God** (v.14–16)
3. **The grace of suffering with Christ and sharing in His glory** (v.17)
4. **The grace of all things** (v.32, 18, 28)
5. **The Holy Spirit’s intercession beyond words**, helping us overcome all weakness (v.26)
6. **The grace of justification by faith**—reconciled with God, free from accusation and condemnation (v.33)
7. **The grace of never being separated from the love of God** (v.35–39)

How can we receive such help from God?

Romans 10:9–10 — Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead.

Romans 10:11–13 — After believing in the Lord:

- Hold firmly that God loves us and will never abandon us; follow Jesus in suffering and walk the heavenly path together.
- Stand firm in faith that God will surely help us endure suffering and overcome all things.
- Continually ask Jesus to help us believe in Him.

You are not striving to grasp “resurrection”—by faith, you have already received it.

God not only gives you new life, but He also leads you to the finish.

After saving you, God does not leave you on your own; He shepherds you all the way to your heavenly home.
