### Scripture Reading: John 21:4-7, 12-15, 17-19

**4** Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus.

**5** He called out to them, “Friends, haven’t you any fish?” “No,” they answered.

**6** He said, “Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some.” When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

**7** Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, “It is the Lord,” he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water.

**12** Jesus said to them, “Come and have breakfast.” None of the disciples dared ask him, “Who are you?” They knew it was the Lord.

**13** Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish.

**14** This was now the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead.

**15** When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?” “Yes, Lord,” he said, “you know that I love you.”

Jesus said, “Feed my lambs.”

**17** The third time he said to him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?” Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, “Do you love me?” He said, “Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you.” Jesus said, “Feed my sheep.

**18** Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go.”

**19** Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, “Follow me!”

### 1. Calling Forth True Feelings

#### 1) Restoring — the Lord Jesus

The Lord Jesus took the initiative to seek out the disciples, not to simply turn the page, but to transform their lives.

All of this is founded upon forgiveness.

#### 2) Rebuilding

What He rebuilt with the disciples was not a relationship of the past, but a relationship for the future.

This relationship is established through mutual self-sacrifice.

### 2. Calling Forth True Love

#### 1) Contrast

Do not focus on evaluating the environment; focus on recognizing the condition of the heart. This is based on whether one thinks according to the soul or discerns according to the Spirit.

#### 2) Entrustment

“Feed My sheep.”

This was not merely a responsibility the Lord Jesus gave to the disciples, but a trust He placed in them.

### 3. Calling Forth Truth

#### 1) Resurrection —

Human transformation does not come through personal effort, but through the power of God.

#### 2) Following

Walking with the Lord is not about what the Lord will do for you, but about what you can do for the Lord.

This is the sanctified resolve of the saints.
