🔑 **Scripture Reading: 1 Kings 19:2-4, 10, 18**

2 So Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah to say, “May the gods deal with me, be it ever so severely, if by this time tomorrow I do not make your life like that of one of them.”

3 Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. When he came to Beersheba in Judah, he left his servant there,

4 while he himself went a day’s journey into the wilderness. He came to a broom bush, sat down under it and prayed that he might die. “I have had enough, LORD,” he said. “Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors.”

10 He replied, “I have been very zealous for the LORD God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, torn down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.”

18 Yet I reserve seven thousand in Israel—all whose knees have not bowed down to Baal and whose mouths have not kissed him.”

🔑 **Sermon: Lord, I Am Truly Sick!**

1 Kings 19:14 He replied, “I have been very zealous for the Lord God Almighty. The Israelites have rejected your covenant, torn down your altars, and put your prophets to death with the sword. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too.”

I. The Pain of Our Brokenness 1 Kings 19:3-4, 10, 14

1 Kings 19:5 Then he lay down under the bush and fell asleep. All at once an angel touched him and said, “Get up and eat.”

1. Burnout – 1 Kings 19:4-5

After fighting battle after battle every day, how could Elijah not be exhausted? The journey never seemed to end, the battles never stopped, and there appeared to be no results or lasting change.

Completely worn out, Elijah fell into deep burnout. Haven't we felt the same way at times?

2. Panic – 1 Kings 19:3

Jezebel, the most powerful and ruthless queen, ordered Elijah's execution. The entire kingdom was hunting him down. With no one to help him, no way forward, and no way back, fear and anxiety overwhelmed him. That kind of panic is not unfamiliar to us.

3. Depression – 1 Kings 19:4

Right after experiencing an incredible victory, Elijah suddenly plunged into complete despair. Such a dramatic emotional crash can leave anyone drowning in depression, losing all motivation and hope. To Elijah, death seemed like the only escape.

4. Self-Pity – 1 Kings 19:10, 14

"Why am I the only one fighting? Why do I have to carry everything alone?" Feeling abandoned, defeated, and miserable, Elijah was overwhelmed by self-pity. He even questioned God's fairness.

5. Accusation – 1 Kings 19:10, 14

"I have been faithful to God, yet everything has fallen apart. Others seem blessed, but why is my life like this?" Elijah poured out his complaints, believing he had every reason to do so.

1 Kings 19:15-18 The LORD said to him, “Go back the way you came, and go to the Desert of Damascus. When you get there, anoint Hazael king over Aram.

16 Also, anoint Jehu son of Nimshi king over Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel Meholah to succeed you as prophet.

17 Jehu will put to death any who escape the sword of Hazael, and Elisha will put to death any who escape the sword of Jehu.

18 Yet I reserve seven thousand in Israel—all whose knees have not bowed down to Baal and whose mouths have not kissed him.”

2 Kings 2:11 As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.

II. The Joy of New Life – 1 Kings 19:15-18; 2 Kings 2:11

1. God Cares—So Speak – 1 Kings 19:4, 10, 14

Bring your deepest pain, fear, loneliness, and sorrow to God without holding back. Our loving Father listens. He has always been listening, and He cares deeply about you. Don't suffer in silence—open your heart in prayer.

1 Kings 19:9, 11, 13 There he went into a cave and spent the night. And the word of the LORD came to him: “What are you doing here, Elijah?”

11 The Lord said, “Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by.”

Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake.

13 When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave. Then a voice said to him, “What are you doing here, Elijah?”

2. God Calls—So Listen – 1 Kings 19:9, 11, 13

Even in our darkest and weakest moments, God still speaks. He desires to speak to us. The question is: Are we willing to listen? Are we eager to hear His voice?

1 Kings 19:11-12 The Lord said, “Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by.”

Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake.

12 After the earthquake came a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper.

3. God Reveals Himself—So Look – 1 Kings 19:11-12

The all-knowing, all-powerful, ever-present God has never stopped working. Look carefully, humbly, and with faith. When we see Him, we find comfort, renewed faith, and fresh strength.

4. God Comforts—So Believe – 1 Kings 19:18

You are not alone. God reminded Elijah that there were still seven thousand faithful believers. Victory and defeat belong to God, not to us. Trust His Word, His promises, His comfort, and His blessings with confidence.

5. God Sends—So Go – 1 Kings 19:15-17

God knows that one of the greatest paths to healing is to keep following Him. Keep running the race. Keep serving. Keep fighting the good

fight. Keep fulfilling the mission God has given you, and He will lead you to victory.
