14 For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.
15 And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

☞Sermon: **Three Ways to Live** ~ Pastor Dong

There are **three ways to live, three different lifestyles, and three different destinations.** We must choose wisely.

I. Living for Others (Psalm 90:9–13)

Psalm 90:9–13 Our days may come to seventy years, or eighty, if our strength endures; yet the best of them are but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away. _

10 Our days may come to seventy years, or eighty, if our strength endures; yet the best of them are but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away.

11 If only we knew the power of your anger! Your wrath is as great as the fear that is your due.

12 Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

13 Relent, Lord! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants.

Moses was clearly waiting for God—waiting for Him to turn back, waiting for Him to no longer remember the sins of Moses and the people.

Without God, without faith in God, or by rejecting God, even if a person lives wholeheartedly for their

country, their people, or others, life can only end like this: A sigh, gone in a moment, flying away like the wind.

II. Living for Yourself

Genesis 3:12 The man said, “The woman you put here with me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it.”

To live for yourself means **making yourself the center of everything.**

Adam — Genesis 3:12

1. **Shifting the blame** – Everything is someone else's fault, even God's.
2. **Selfishness** – Genesis 3:12
Sacrificing others to protect yourself.

A selfish heart becomes **blind, deaf, and insensitive.**

Result: Adam was driven out of the garden and had to work by the sweat of his brow just to survive.

Genesis 4:5–7, 13–15 but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor. So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast.

6 Then the Lord said to Cain, “Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast?”

7 If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it.”

13–15 Cain said to the Lord, “My punishment is more than I can bear.

14 Today you are driving me from the land, and I will be hidden from your presence; I will be a restless wanderer on the earth, and whoever finds me will kill me.”

15 But the Lord said to him, “Not so[a]; anyone who kills Cain will suffer vengeance seven times over.” Then the Lord put a mark on Cain so that no one who found him would kill him.

Cain — Genesis 4:5–7, 13–15

Pride led Cain to:

Jealousy, Rivalry, Bitterness. These eventually turned into violent, uncontrolled behavior, bringing unbearable pain and a curse upon his life.

The Way Out: Psalm 90:11–15

How can we receive God's salvation and return to Him?

Psalm 90:11–15 If only we knew the power of your anger!

Your wrath is as great as the fear that is your due.

12 Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

13 Relent, Lord! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants.

14 Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days.

15 Make us glad for as many days as you have afflicted us, for as many years as we have seen trouble.

III. Living for the Lord (**2 Corinthians 5:14–15**)

1. Those who live for the Lord no longer live for themselves, but for the Lord who died and rose again for them.

This means choosing to: Live for the Lord in everything. Seek His will in every situation. Obey Him. Depend on Him alone. Give all glory to Him.

2. Those who live for the Lord live noble and meaningful lives that glorify God and bless others.

The Apostle Paul's life is a beautiful testimony of living for Christ.

1) **Defeat turns into victory beyond imagination.**

2 Corinthians 6:9–10

2) **God gives His power, making all things possible.**

2 Corinthians 4:8–10

3) **Never losing heart, but being renewed day by day.**

2 Corinthians 4:16

4) **Receiving an eternal glory that far outweighs all troubles.**

2 Corinthians 4:17

2 Corinthians 6:9–10 known, yet regarded as unknown; dying, and yet we live on; beaten, and yet not killed;

10 sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; poor, yet making many rich; having nothing, and yet possessing everything.

2 Corinthians 4:8–10 We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair;

9 persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.

10 We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body.

2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

2 Corinthians 4:18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

How can we live for the Lord?

3. The key is to fix our eyes on what is unseen and eternal, not on what is seen. 2 Corinthians 4:18

Make God's glory and loving others your lifelong focus—not yourself.

Then, in every moment and every situation, you will naturally choose to: Live for the Lord in everything. Seek His will. Obey Him. Depend on Him alone. Give all glory to Him.

This means:

1) **Deny yourself.**

2) **Faithfully carry out God's mission and live by His truth.**

What a noble, beautiful, and meaningful life—a life that glorifies God and blesses others!

What we focus on determines whom we live for.
