🔑Sermon: A Consciousness of Glory

A consciousness of glory is the greatest glory God has given to His saints. It is a glory that the world can never take away!

Everyone who repents of their sins and receives Jesus into their heart receives this glory.

We should not only possess this glory; we should enjoy it and live it out!

Ephesians 1:18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people,

This consciousness of glory comes from:

I. I Have:

1. A new nature (**1 Corinthians 1:30; Philippians 1:8; 2 Peter 1:4; Philippians 2:5**)

1 Corinthians 1:30 It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

Philippians 1:8 God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.

2 Peter 1:4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

Philippians 2:5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

2. A new perspective (**2 Corinthians 5:16**)

2 Corinthians 5:16 So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer.

3. A new power (**Ephesians 1:19–20**)

Ephesians 1:19–20 and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength

20 he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,

4. A new image (**2 Corinthians 3:18; Galatians 3:27**)

2 Corinthians 3:18 And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Galatians 3:27 for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

5. A new heaven and a new earth—the Kingdom of God (**Luke 12:32; 22:29; Ephesians 2:5–6**)

Luke 12:32; 22:29 “Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom.

22:29 And I confer on you a kingdom, just as my Father conferred one on me,

Ephesians 2:5–6 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus,

I have all these things because:

II. I Am:

I am a child of God. (**John 1:12–13; Galatians 3:26, 4:6; Ephesians 2:8, 1:18**)

John 1:12–13 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—

13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Galatians 3:26, 4:6 So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith,

4:6 Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “Abba, Father.”

Ephesians 2:8, 1:18 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—

1:18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people,

May God open the eyes of our hearts so that we can see and know that we are God's children!

This grace is by grace through faith.

I have nothing to boast about, and I have nothing to worry about.

I will stand firm: I would rather lose everything than ever give up this identity!

III. I Will:

1. Believe in God—believe in Him alone (**John 1:12–13; Philippians 3:8; 2 Timothy 1:12**)

Philippians 3:8 What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ

2 Timothy 1:12 That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet this is no cause for shame, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until that day.

2. Glorify God—glorify Him alone (**1 Corinthians 10:31; 1 Peter 2:9**)

1 Corinthians 10:31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

3. Gaze upon God—draw near to Him continually (**Proverbs 6:22; 2 Corinthians 3:18**)

Proverbs 6:22 When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.

2 Corinthians 3:18 And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

4. Despise the world's contempt (**Hebrews 12:2**)

Hebrews 12:2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

1 Peter 5:4 And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away.

1:4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you,

5. Live out Christ (**Galatians 2:20; Philippians 1:21; 1 Peter 2:9**)

Follow Jesus' example: empty Himself and love God the Father, proclaim God, deny Himself and love others, humble Himself and honor others, and faithfully take responsibility.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Philippians 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Rise up! Believe in Christ, gaze upon Christ, despise the world's contempt, live out Christ, and glorify Christ!

isaiah 14:12–15 How you have fallen from heaven, morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations!

13 You said in your heart, "I will ascend to the heavens;

I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of Mount Zaphon.

14 I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High."

15 But you are brought down to the realm of the dead, to the depths of the pit.

(Isaiah 14:12–15) Satan's five "I wills" caused him to lose God, lose his glory, and fall into the depths of darkness.

But we pursue another five "I wills," so that we may enjoy and reflect God's glory and bring glory to God!
